2. Election of Chair and Vice Chair:

On motion, Councillor Dennison and Councillor Lancaster, were elected as Chair and Vice-Chair, respectively, of Committee of the Whole - Workshop, effective January 1, 2017 for the term to expire December 31, 2017.

3.1 Delegation from John Ariens, IBI Group representing New Horizon Development Group regarding the New Official Plan Review: Rural, Natural Heritage and Sustainability Policy Directions (PB-83-16)

John Ariens, IBI Group, appeared to speak on behalf of Bridgeview Community – Wedgewood Golf Centre. Ariens relayed concerns regarding development opportunities on these lands. Ariens suggested that future development on the property include intensification and a potential mobility hub.

3.2 Delegation from Michael Wilson regarding the New Official Plan Review: Rural, Natural Heritage and Sustainability Policy Directions (PB-83-16)

Michael Wilson appeared to speak regarding Forterra Brick and the proposed quarry expansion. Wilson relayed concerns regarding health,

deforestation and other negative impacts related to an expansion. Wilson encouraged committee to provide support to the residents in the area.

3.3 Delegation from Guy Sheppard representing Burlington Sustainable Development Committee regarding the New Official Plan Review: Rural, Natural Heritage and Sustainability Policy Directions (PB-83-16)

Guy Sheppard, representing the Burlington Sustainable Development Committee appeared to provide comments regarding the staff recommendations. Sheppard provided suggestions for staff to consider when developing the new official plan policies. Considerations included the creation of community gardens in the rural area, the economic viability of farming, and consideration of a model used by Toronto to plan natural heritage systems.

5.1 New Official Plan Review: Rural, Natural Heritage and Sustainability Policy Directions (PB-83-16)

Endorse the policy directions, as detailed in PB-83-16, which relate to the City's Official Plan guiding principles and land use vision for the rural community, the agricultural system, the natural heritage system, mineral aggregates, cultural heritage landscapes, golf courses, and sustainability for the purpose of developing the New Official Plan; and

Receive the Draft Sustainable Building and Development Guidelines dated November, 2016 and Implementation Summary, as contained in Appendix I; and

Direct the Director of Planning and Building to communicate and engage with the public on the policy directions, the Draft Official Plan schedules and the Draft Sustainable Building and Development Guidelines, prior to bringing forward the New Official Plan; and

Endorse the Potential Strategic Initiatives and Advocacy Matters identified in Section 4.0 of Planning and Building department report PB-83-16; and

Direct the Director of Planning and Building to organize and coordinate a City-wide review of the matters outlined in Section 4.0 of Planning and Building department report PB-83-16 and report back to Council with recommendations following adoption of the New Official Plan.
