5. Approval of Minutes:

7.1 Election of Chair and Vice Chair

- The committee is looking for host families for the citizen delegation that will be travelling to Burlington in September 2020.
- Canada-Netherlands Friendship Day will be on May 30, 2020. Details to be confirmed.

7.3 Itabashi subcommittee update

Rob provided the following update:

- Shared comments from students that visited from Japan in August. Most common comments were that the trip was too short, and how much they appreciated the hospitality. The highlights of the trip were Niagara Falls, Blue Jays game and pizza party.
- Working on an art exchange that will take place at the Art Gallery of Burlington from May 18-31, 2020.
- The Sakura Festival is planned for Saturday May 9, 2020, at the Art Gallery of Burlington. Arrangements for entertainment is underway.
- Motion to spend up to \$200 for Japanese Swordmaker Pierre Nadeau's travel expenses. Carried.

7.4 United Nations subcommittee update
