7.1 Transportation Update

- Downtown multi-use path from Ontario Street to Graham's Lane should be built by the end of this year.
- RPM installing three bike repair stations - Appleby and Centennial multi-use path, Roly Bird Park and possibly City Hall. Members suggested the Alton area -Hayden High School as another possibility?
- Public Information Centre (PIC) for the Lakeshore Road resurfacing project from the hospital to Eastport Drive will be held on May 4/17 at the Art Gallery of Burlington from 5:30 to 7 p.m.
- Bike to School Week promotion has started - will be giving bike racks away to schools that register by May 16.
- Bike to Work Day is May 29 - more information will follow.
