- Increased Efficiencies and Productivity: Increased employee motivation, retention, and reduced absenteeism
- An Inclusive Community: Instead of working two or three jobs to make up for low wages, with increased economic equality and access to one full-time and living wage job, employees have increased time to volunteer, spend with family and participate in community
- Increased Regional Economic Growth: More money circulating in the local economy; when people earn more they spend their money in communities There is also an increased tax base to draw on.
- Decreased Poverty: A living wage reduces dependence on social services such as food banks, energy cost-relief programs, and enables families to take better care of their health and wellbeing.
