#### 7.1 Transportation update

- There are 3-4 interested instructors who want to provide Can-bike training. In class and on-road training to take place in early Spring 2018.
- Bike rodeos at elementary schools hosted by Share the Road were a huge success. Great media coverage and our goal is to expand this in 2018.
- Media release reminding pedestrians and cyclists to follow proper etiquette and safe practices when using shared pathways went out the end of October. As part of the media release, we offered free bike lights and bells which has received alot of interest.
- Cycling giveaways have been received. Still looking to order more bike lights either through our supplier or Share the Road.
- Marilu's Market at Walkers Line and New Street asked about the bike rack giveaway program. Thanks to James for reaching out to them.
- Consultant for the Cycling Master Plan will be in Burlington November 27 and 28. She would like to go on a bike ride with Cycling Committee members on November 27 at 1 p.m. and meet on November 28 at 7 p.m., Transportation meeting room, City Hall.
