




Recommendation 1

Approve the proposed New Official Plan

- Our current Official Plan has been proven to be no longer defendable at the OMB.
- OMB test is whether a given development application is compliant:
 - The Planning Act 1990
 - The Provincial Policy Statement 2014
 - The Big Move (Regional Transportation Plan) 2008
 - Places to Grow Greater Golden Horseshoe 2017
 - Halton Regional Official Plan
 - Burlington Official Plan
- · Increasing Provincial policy emphasis of transit and intensification
- · Proposed Official Plan incorporates most of these new policy statements
- · Amendments can always be made as conditions warrant


Develop Intensification and Transit Plans


- "The City may not quite be able to meet the minimum required target for intensification".
- Map Provincial intensification targets over City's proposed Land Use Schedules B through H to determine opportunities and risks.
- Rigorously defend stable residential neighbourhoods from unwarranted effects due to development intensification of bordering and/or overshadowing developments. (3 Illustrations)
- Explore the imposition of traffic by-laws to protect stable residential neighbourhoods from unnecessary rerouting of traffic i.e. as a result of a major accident associated with the QEW or Highway 403. Ideally this effort would include the notification of mobile map service providers to not indicate an alternative path through any designated neighbourhoods.
- Ensure that maximum heights are specified for each precincts and justification for each maximum height is documented i.e. to ensure appropriate transition to steady residential neighbourhoods.



Recommendation 3

Enhance Burlington Transit to serve developments in Urban Growth Areas and Intensification Corridors & Larger Nodes

- Metrolinx projects of benefit to Burlington appear to be focused on GO
 Train Lakeshore West corridor both in terms of increasing service to
 every 15 minutes between Aldershot to Union Station in 2024 and by
 extending service all the way to Niagara Falls with stops in between.
- The provision of first/last mile transportation appears to remain with municipal transit authorities.
- Intensification developments in the downtown core are dependent upon frequent transit on Brant St., between the Lakeshore and the Burlington GO Station.
- Intensification Corridor associated with Plains Rd. and Fairview St. warrants frequent transit.
