The purpose of this report is to transmit the 2017 annual report from ADR Chambers, Ombudsman for the City of Burlington.

Background and Discussion:

The *Public Sector and MPP Accountability and Transparency Act* came into force on January 1, 2016. This legislation expanded the function of the provincial Ombudsman to include investigation of decisions or recommendations with respect to the administrative acts of a municipality. The *Municipal Act* allows a municipality to appoint an Ombudsman to have the same responsibility for conducting investigations with respect to these administrative acts of the municipality. In January 2016, Council appointed ADR Chambers as the Ombudsman for the City of Burlington. As part of the agreement with ADR Chambers they are required to submit an annual report to Council. The 2017 annual report is attached as Appendix A.

Financial Matters:

The administrative fee for ADR Chambers is \$1,000 per month. There are additional costs for investigations and for 2017 the additional costs were approximately \$2,500.

Conclusion:

This report transmits the annual report from ADR Chambers.
