

BY-LAW NUMBER XX-2018

A By-law to amend Sign By-law 34-2007

Whereas subsection 11(3), paragraph 7 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, CHAPTER 25, authorizes the City of Burlington to pass by-laws respecting signs; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary to amend By-law 34-2007.

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 34-2007 be amended by adding the following section:

6.8.5 Notwithstanding the provisions of By-law 34-2007, one static digital billboard shall be permitted on the lands identified as Part of Lots 14 and 15 Concession, 3 S.D.S., being Part 3 on 20R-19508 – Metrolinx corridor, north of Fairview Street and east of Guelph Line, with the following conditions:

- i) each message shall be displayed for a minimum of ten (10) seconds;
 - ii) the maximum sign area shall be 8.5 m²;
 - iii) the maximum height shall be 10 meters; and
 - iv) ambient light monitors shall automatically adjust the brightness level of the digital billboard based on ambient light conditions.
2. That in all other respects By-law 34-2007 be and is hereby confirmed.
