







## Sidewalks and safety

The likelihood of a vehicle/pedestrian crash is 88% lower on streets with sidewalks than on streets without sidewalks.

"The presence of a sidewalk clearly has a strong beneficial effect of reducing the risk of a [...] pedestrian/motor vehicle crash"
