
On September 14, 2019 staff participated in the City's Food for Feedback Community Engagement BBQ. Staff from the Department of City Building and the City Manager's Office collected feedback regarding the City's ongoing Cannabis Production Study. The following background/introductory information was provided to community participants:

Not all participants answered both questions and not all participants initialed the signature sheet. The total number of signatures collected for question 1 is 127 and 109 for question 2. For question 2, the following additional feedback was provided via written comments:

- "I'm against cannabis production and use. I don't really see benefit for the community other [than] causing more harm especially for the younger generation. It's just lack of responsibility of the federal government which is being driven by staying in power and industry."
- "Strongly against cannabis production. I don't see any benefit from it. This [is] truly harmful to the society and children."
- "Also lighting over facilities in urban areas. Impact on environment re: energy usage."
- "Positioning- land that is not being used (empty warehouses etc.)- sure, but no to taking up greenspace or agricultural land."
