

City of Burlington By-law 67-2014

Description

A By-law to amend By-law 16-1993, a By-law to amend By-law 128-1985, being a by-law to establish a Community Heritage Fund. File No. 501-06-07 (PB-82-14)

Preamble

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington enacted By-law number 16-1993 to insert parameters around the issuing of grants and loans from the Community Heritage Fund; and

Whereas a complete review of the Community Heritage Fund is required to be completed; and

Whereas Council deems it necessary to amend By-law number 16-1993 prior to the review of the Community Heritage Fund.

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

Content

1. That By-law number 16-1993 be amended by deleting the following paragraph:

“4: That, as a condition of any grant from the Burlington Community Heritage Fund, the owner agrees to provide, at no charge, a heritage conservation easement.” That the parcels of land listed below and situated in the City of Burlington in the Regional Municipality of Halton be and the same are hereby assumed as public highway:

2. That By-law number 16-1993 be amended by adding the following paragraph:

“4: That, as a condition of any grant from the Burlington Community Heritage Fund, the owner agrees to provide, at no charge, a heritage conservation agreement, subject to the satisfaction of the City Solicitor and the Director of Planning & Building.”

3. That all in all other respects By-law number 16-1993 remains the same.
