Tourism in Halton

A tourism study completed in 2007 in conjunction with local municipalities and the province by the Halton Region showed that the main attractions in the region was our waterfront and rural landscapes, outdoor recreation and escarpment (Conservation Halton, Bronte Creek Provincial Park), the Royal Botanical Gardens, and authentic farm experiences. In Burlington, visitors also enjoy our cultural facilities and festivals with friends and family.

Halton Tourism Impact

- Total visitor spending \$303.5M (\$101M Burlington)
- Total person visits 4.3M (1.4M Burlington)
- 25% are overnight visitors
 - 87% of overnight stays are with friends/relatives
- Purpose of trip
 - 64% are visiting friends & relatives
 - 22% pleasure trip
 - 6% business/conferences
 - 5% shopping
- Average nights stayed 2.1
- Average age 44.8 years
