#### **Recommendation:**

Approve the amendment to Traffic By-Law 86-2007, as amended, and noted in Appendix A to transportation services department report TS-18-19.

### Purpose:

Installation of warranted 40km/h speed limits as per the Council approved Speed Limit Policy and by-law amendments for the flashing 40km/h school zone speed limits.

## **Background and Discussion:**

## **Speed Limit Reviews**

Staff has reviewed nine streets at the request of residents to determine if a reduced speed limit is warranted. Staff also reviewed roadways adjacent to warranted speed limit reduced roads to ensure a consistent speed limit is in place for the neighbourhood.

To determine the appropriate speed limit for a roadway, staff utilize the Transportation Association of Canada's Speed Limit Guidelines Calculation Sheet as part of the revised Speed Limit Policy, adopted by Council in 2012. Through this review staff has determined that the roadways outlined in Appendix A meet the Speed Limit Policy criteria to implement a reduced speed limit.

#### Flashing 40km/h School Zones

Staff has determined there are changes to the 2019/2020 school times which will require timing changes to the existing flashing 40km/h school zones. The required changes to the flashing 40km/h school zones will be reflected in the amending by-law presented to Council for approval.

#### **Financial Matters:**

The estimated cost to install the necessary speed limit signage is \$4,000.00.

### **Total Financial Impact**

Not Applicable.

### Source of Funding

The proposed works are to be funded through Capital Order TC0037.

### **Public Engagement Matters:**

All residents on each roadway will be notified of the warranted speed limit change and anticipated installation date.

#### **Conclusion:**

Based on the Council approved Speed Limit Policy, a speed limit reduction is warranted for the roadways outlined within Appendix A. These speed limit changes will result in speed limits that better match the expectation of road users, provide consistency in the application of speed limits and are compatible with the physical characteristics of the roadway and road classification.

Staff has also determined there are required timing changes to the existing flashing 40km/h school zones and the required amendment to Traffic By-Law 86-2007, Schedule 13 is outlined in Appendix A to transportation services department report TS-18-19.
