Recommendation:

Award the tender for contract CW-20-02, Belvenia Road, Lomond Crescent and Ayr Place Reconstruction to DESO Construction Limited, 135 Highway 56, Caledonia, ON, for \$4,516,610.00 including HST, subject to the approval of Halton Region; and

Authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign any required agreements with the bidder named above, subject to the satisfaction of the City Solicitor; and

Approve the total cost of \$4,644,075 (Net HST) to be charged to Capital Order RL0327and funded as follows;

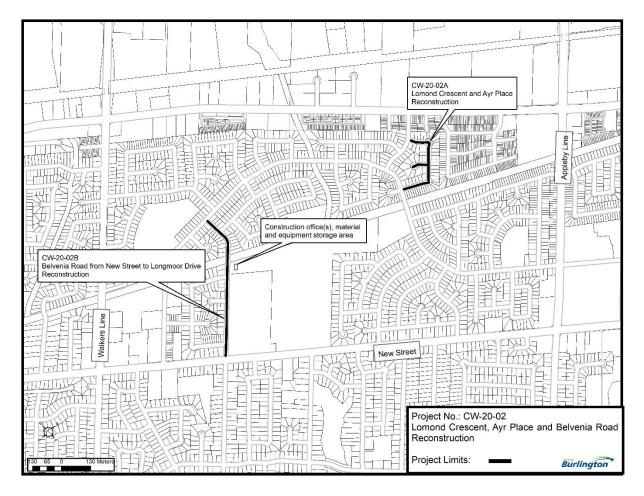

Proposed Works:

This project includes for the following works:

Lomond Crescent	Watermain, curb and asphalt replacement with minor storm repairs.
Ayr Place	Wastewater main, watermain, curb and asphalt replacement with storm sewer replacement.
Belvenia Road New Street to Longmoor Drive	Watermain, curb and asphalt replacement with minor storm repairs.

Road Closures and Lane Restrictions:

The project will have full road closures for the watermain and sanitary sewer installation. Access for residents will be maintained.

For Belvenia Road, in the proximity of Nelson High School, works will be undertaken during July and August to reduce impact on school users.

Construction Schedule:

All works, except	for the top layer of	asphalt, will be	completed	between	May to
December 2020.	Final layer of aspl	nalt will be place	ed in July 20	21.

This tender was part of the general contractor prequalification. Twenty-three general contractors were prequalified to bid this work.

Note 1: Halton Region watermain and wastewater main construction is included in the tender. Halton Region share of city roadworks is identified as the External Recovery in the City's Capital Budget. Watermain and wastewater main are budgeted for in Halton's Capital Budget only.

Total Financial Impact

The total capital budget approved for the city component is \$1,551,000. The total City costs for this project at tender award is now estimated to be \$1,827,026 for an overage of \$276,026. This project is over budget due to higher than anticipated unit rates.

The additional funding will be provided from the Federal Gas Tax available from savings from the 2019 Capital Projects.

Climate Implications

City Staff specify the use of recycled materials throughout the contract to reduce the amount of waste generated through the renewal and replacement of City roadways. Staff continue to strive to plant trees wherever feasible within the capital project in order to improve our urban canopy.

A Consulting arborist was retained to complete a preconstruction review of the existing street trees and provide recommendations to minimize construction damage to the trees. The consulting arborist will be on site completing tree audits during construction.

Three (3) trees on Ayr Place and one (1) tree on Belvenia Road are at risk of being significantly affected during construction and may require removal. Trees removed will be replaced on a minimum of a 1:1 basis where site conditions allow.

The City Arborist has been consulted and involved with all the tree decisions.

Engagement Matters:

A Public Information Meeting was held on Wednesday December 4, 2019 at Robert Bateman High School.

Area residents and impacted school boards were notified by:

- Direct mail, and
- Advertisement in the Burlington Post.

The meeting provided

- Construction Plans
- Construction Schedule
- An open forum for resident questions.

The plans were generally well received with only some property specific concerns.

Upon award of this contract, letters will be delivered to affected homes prior to the beginning of construction. As construction progresses, project updates will be delivered to affected residents on a regular basis. The project updates and associated road closure information will also be made available on the City's website.

Conclusion:

Staff are recommending that tender CW-20-02, Belvenia Road, Lomond Crescent and Ayr Place be awarded to DESO Construction Limited.
