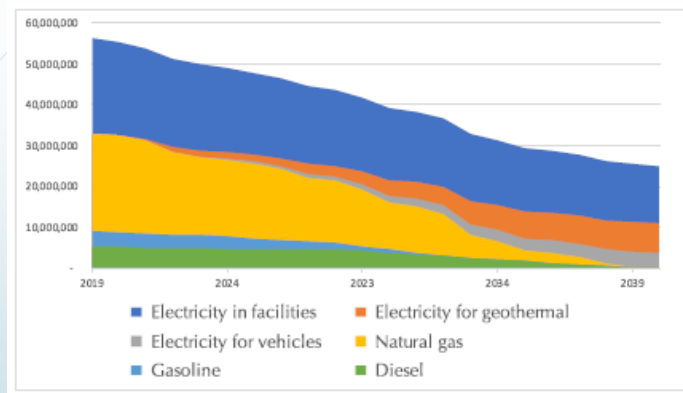

CEEMP – What If Scenario



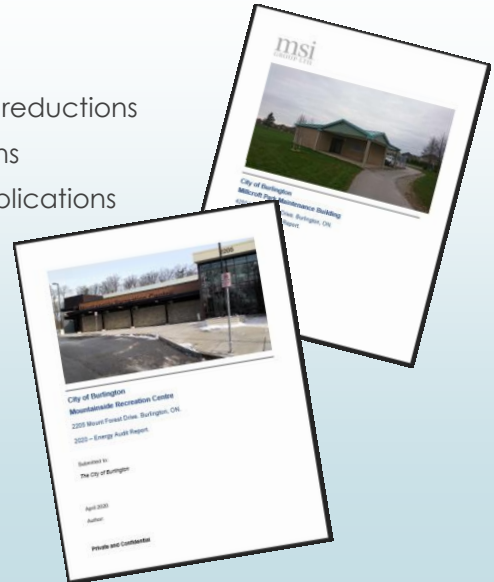
- Geothermal Energy to offset all Natural Gas usage

- A new round of studies to begin shortly



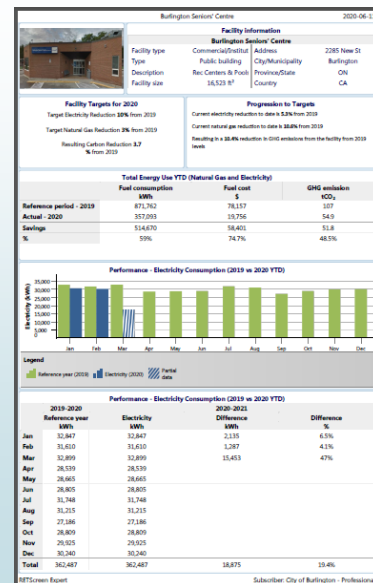
