- Up until 1930, private power companies provided Burlington with power.
- From 1930 to 1945, the provincially-owned Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario took over the operation of Burlington's power system.




On July 6, 1945, the Burlington Public Utilities Commission was created under two branches, Water and Hydro. Burlington PUC, and later the Burlington Hydro-Electric Commission (both predecessors of Burlington Hydro), operated in a not-for-profit capacity.

Burlington Hydro was incorporated and wholly transferred into the ownership of the City of Burlington on January 1, 2000 as a for-profit company.
