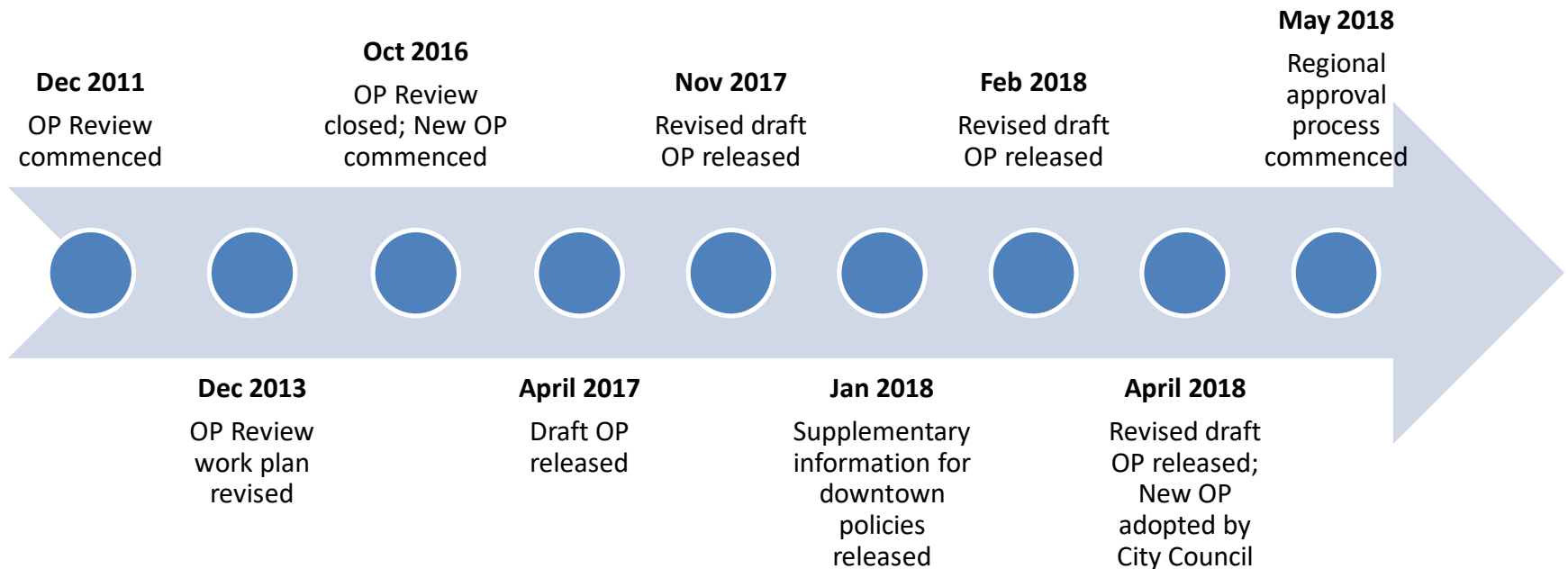

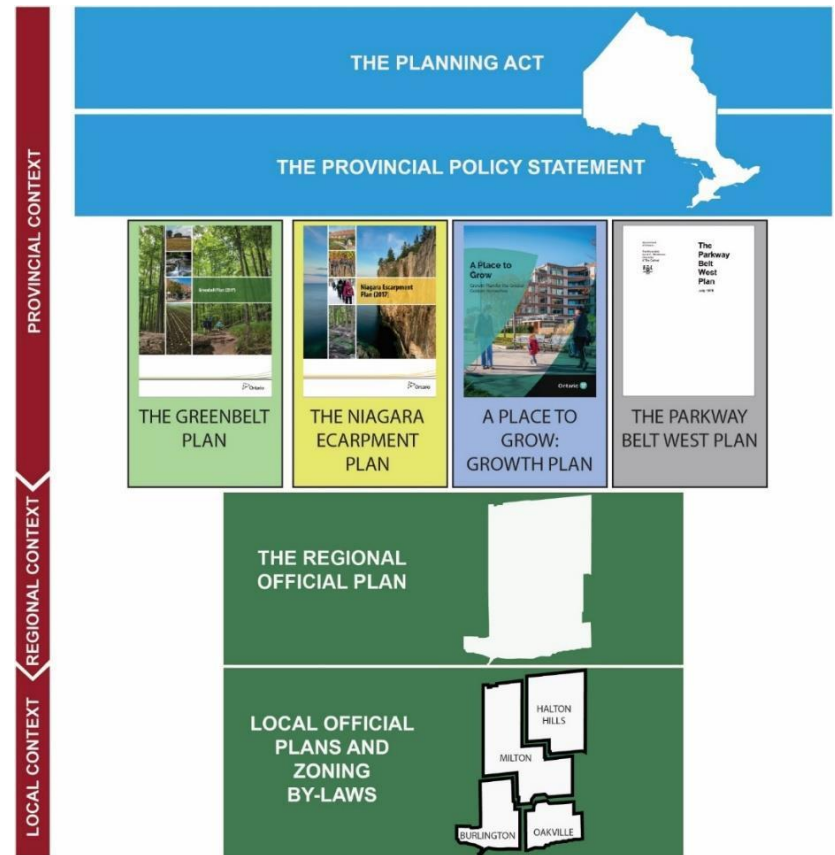
New Official Plan Project – Timeline



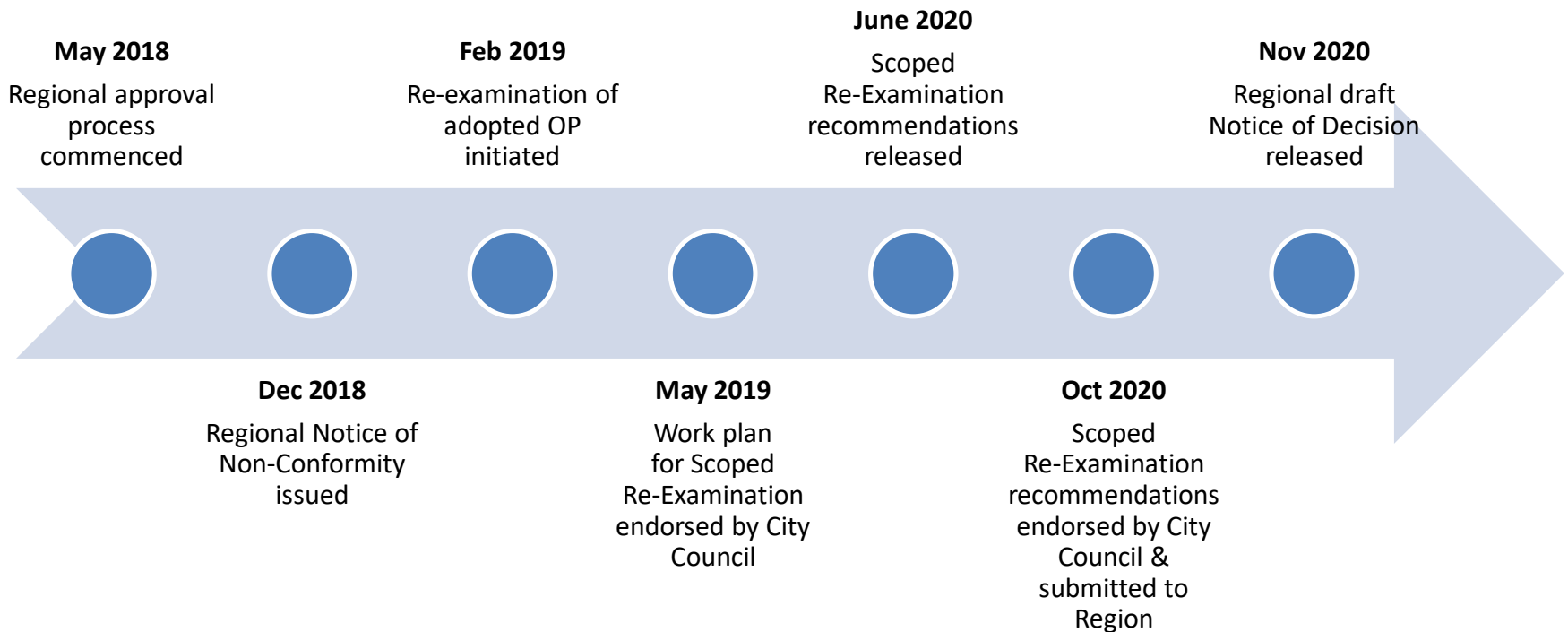
Halton Region Approval Process

As the approval authority, Halton Region must ensure that the City's New Official Plan:

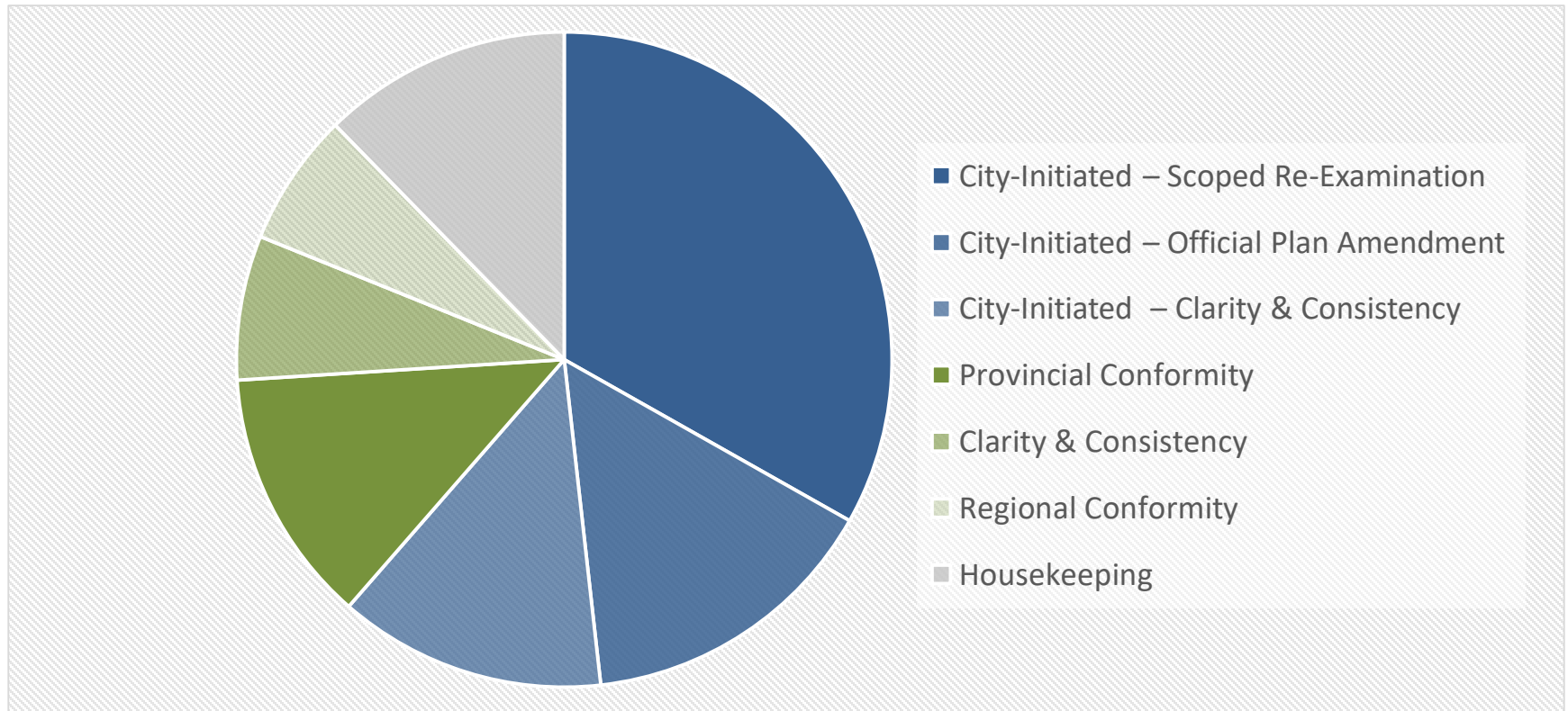
- conforms to or does not conflict with the Regional Official Plan;
- is consistent with the Provincial Policy Statement; and
- conforms to or does not conflict with applicable Provincial plans.

Key Region-Initiated Modifications

Employment	Clarification of conversion processes/agency roles & minor refinements to permitted uses.
Agriculture	Refinements to permitted uses in prime agricultural areas & incorporation of Growth Plan Agricultural Land Base mapping
Natural Heritage	Incorporation of Growth Plan policies & removal of Growth Plan Natural Heritage System mapping
Transportation	Clarification of Major Transit Station Area boundary delineation processes/agency roles & refinement of road classifications
North Aldershot	Clarification of Regional/Provincial policies & impacts of the Region's ongoing Municipal Comprehensive Review process

Key City-Initiated Modifications

Scoped Re-Examination	Incorporation of recommendations endorsed by City Council through the Downtown policy review & Neighbourhood Centres policy refinement.
Official Plan Amendments	Incorporation of OPAs approved between April 2018 and Oct 2020, including OPA No. 119 which implements the findings of the Interim Control By-Law Land Use Study
Other	Removal of the Clearview/Queen Mary/St. Matthews neighbourhood from the Aldershot GO Major Transit Station Area Special Planning Area Boundary
