

Main Street Business and COVID-19

- Several municipalities have already provided support for small business, including the provision of PPE, waiving fees, tax deferrals, \$25,000 to \$100,000 loans, and/or grants in some cases.
- We are unable to provide a direct subsidy to a Main Street Business.
- Some options include:
 - Expansion of Halton Region Small Business Centre's Starter Company Plus Program
 - Grants to cover PPE
 - Main Street Businesses report spending \$800 \$5,000 on PPE
 - Leverage Digital Main Street Programming.



Main Street Business and COVID-19

- Recommendation:
 - Earmark \$125,000 in funds as a COVID-19 Expense to support main street business and
 - Request that Halton Region match these funds
 - Recommend a Main Street Business Funding Program and appropriate delivery partners
 - Support digital presence and safe in-person experience.
