In the attached Excel file, you will find 1,981 occurrences involving 2,129 bicycles from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015 through to December 15, 2020. Occurrences were not filtered out by any metric.

Interpreting this table produces the following takeaways:

- Of the 2,136 bicycles involved
  - o 819 remain lost or stolen
  - o 1,317 were found
- Of the 1,317 bicycles found
  - o 999 were auctioned
  - o 318 were not auctioned
  - o 177 were returned to owner (1 via auction)
  - o 142 were neither returned to owner nor auctioned and presumably remain in storage or were disposed of by other means
