## The Corporation of the City of Burlington

City of Burlington By-law 27-2021

A by-law to designate the Community Improvement Project Area File: 125 (ECDEV-02-21)

Whereas Section 28(2) of Part IV of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, empowers the Council of a municipality in which an Official Plan is in effect and contains provisions relating to community improvement to designate the whole or any part of the municipality covered by the Official Plan as a Community Improvement Project Area; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington has an existing Official Plan "The Burlington Official Plan" adopted in 1994, and approved by Halton Region in 1997; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington has a new Official Plan adopted on April 26, 2018 and approved by Halton Region on November 30, 2020; and

Whereas the City of Burlington Official Plan (1997) and the new Official Plan (2020) both contain provisions relating to community improvement in the City.

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That all land within the urban boundary of the City of Burlington, as amended from time to time, be designated as the Community Improvement Project Area and is hereafter known as the Community Improvement Project Area.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force in accordance with the provisions of *The Planning Act*, R.S.O 1990, c.P.13, as amended.
