The City of Burlington recognizes the importance of the United Nations sustainable development goals (SDG). With the 2015 declaration, "The sustainable development goals are a call for action by all countries – poor, rich and middle-income – to promote prosperity while protecting the planet. They recognize that ending poverty must go hand-in-hand with strategies that build economic growth and address a range of social needs including education, health, social protection, and job opportunities, while tackling climate change and environmental protection. More important than ever, the goals provide a critical framework for COVID-19 recovery."

As Burlington defined its vision for the future, a number of factors influenced, and continue to influence, the long term goals. Burlington's work to achieve its long-term vision align and support the SDG. Burlington's advocacy work for increased cooperation with and between Regional, Provincial and Federal governments, while not an aspirational goal, is a testament to Burlington's commitment to SDG #17 - strengthen the means of implementation and revitalize the global partnership for sustainable development.
