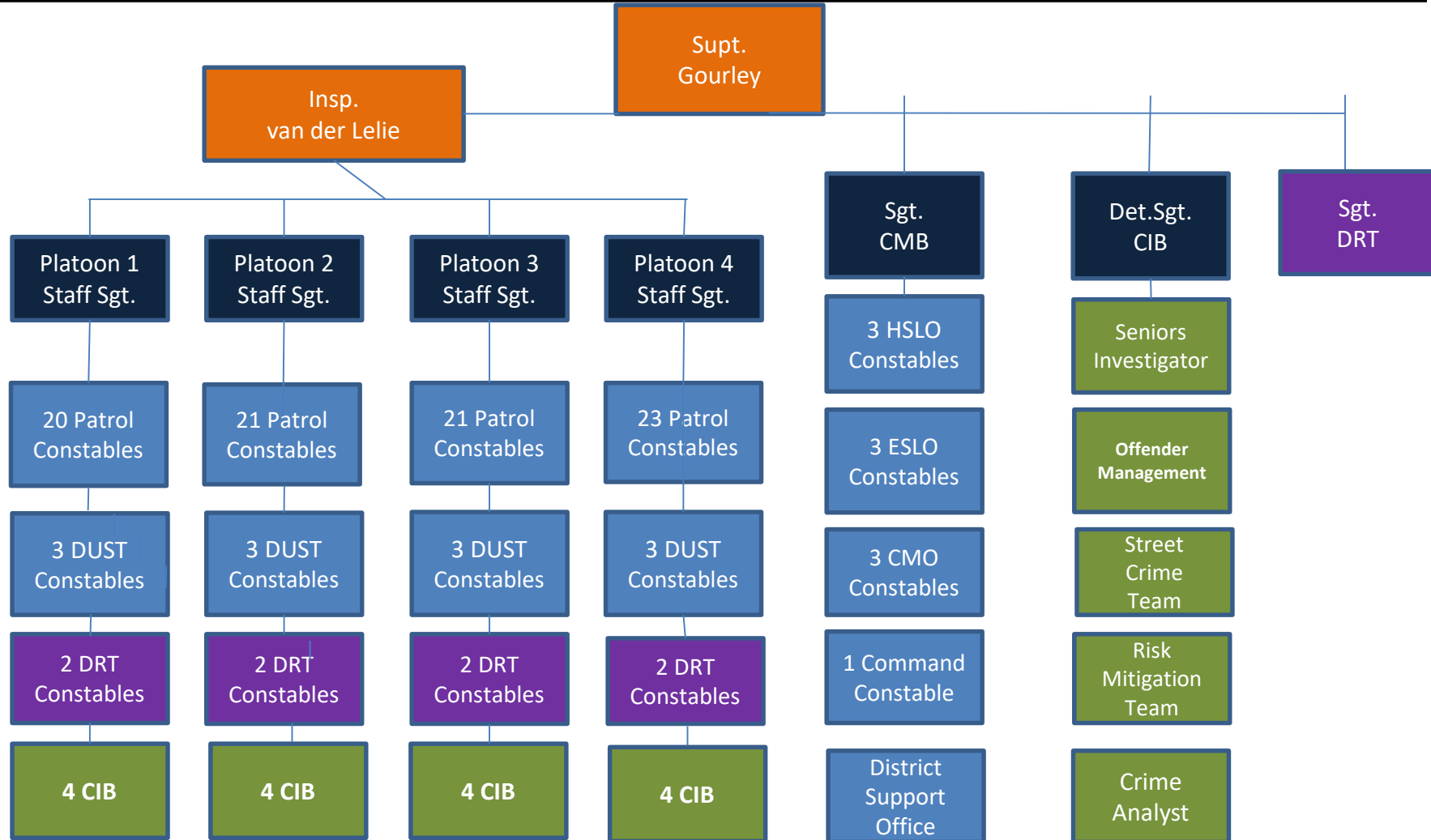

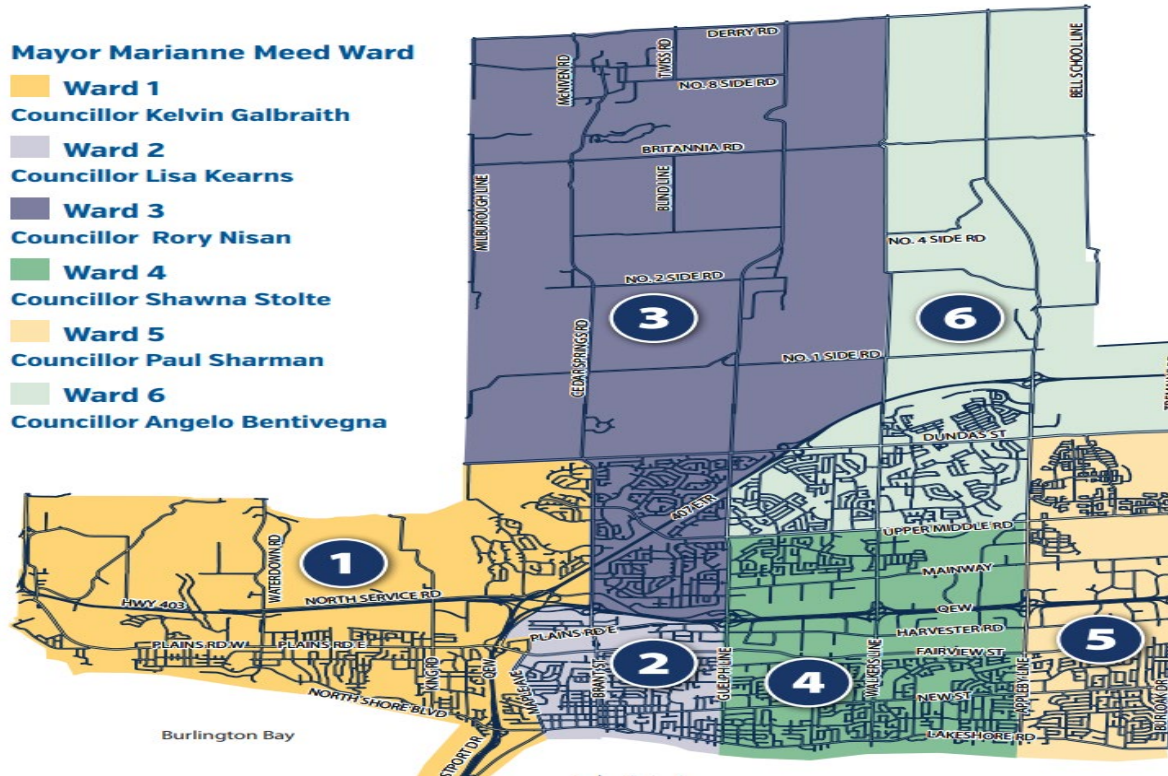

3 District Command Triangle





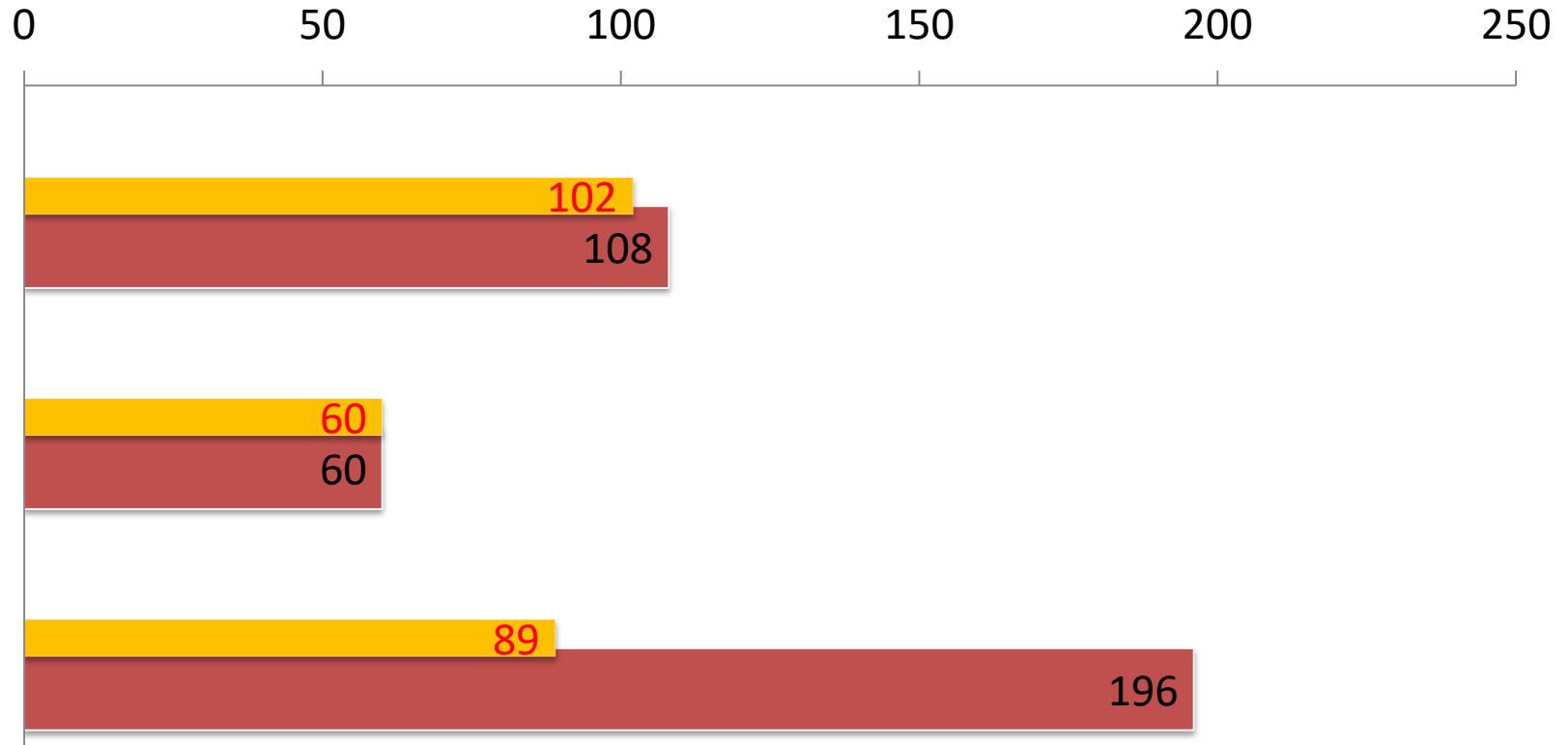
Crime and Occurrence Trends

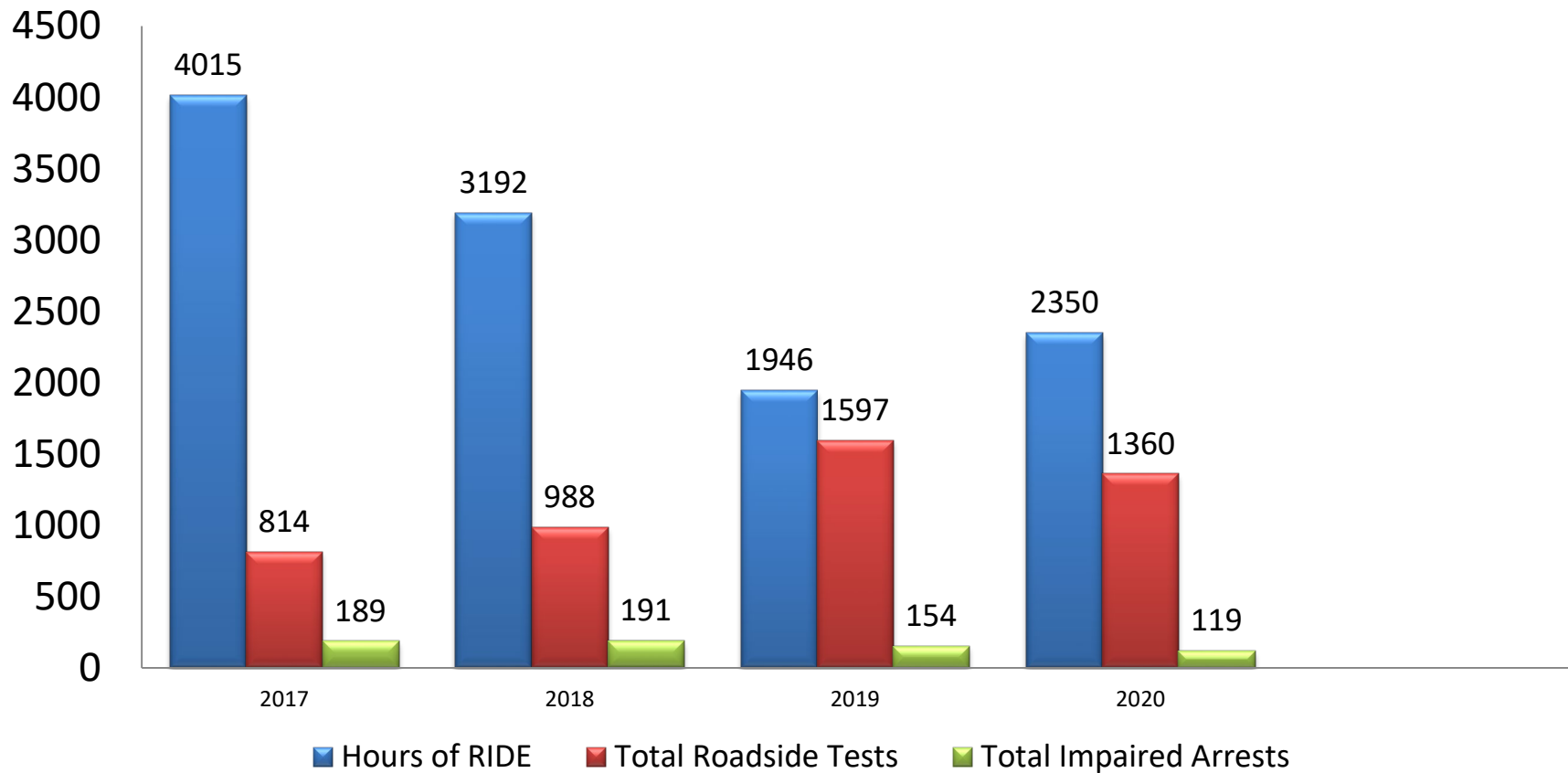

Motor Vehicle Collisions

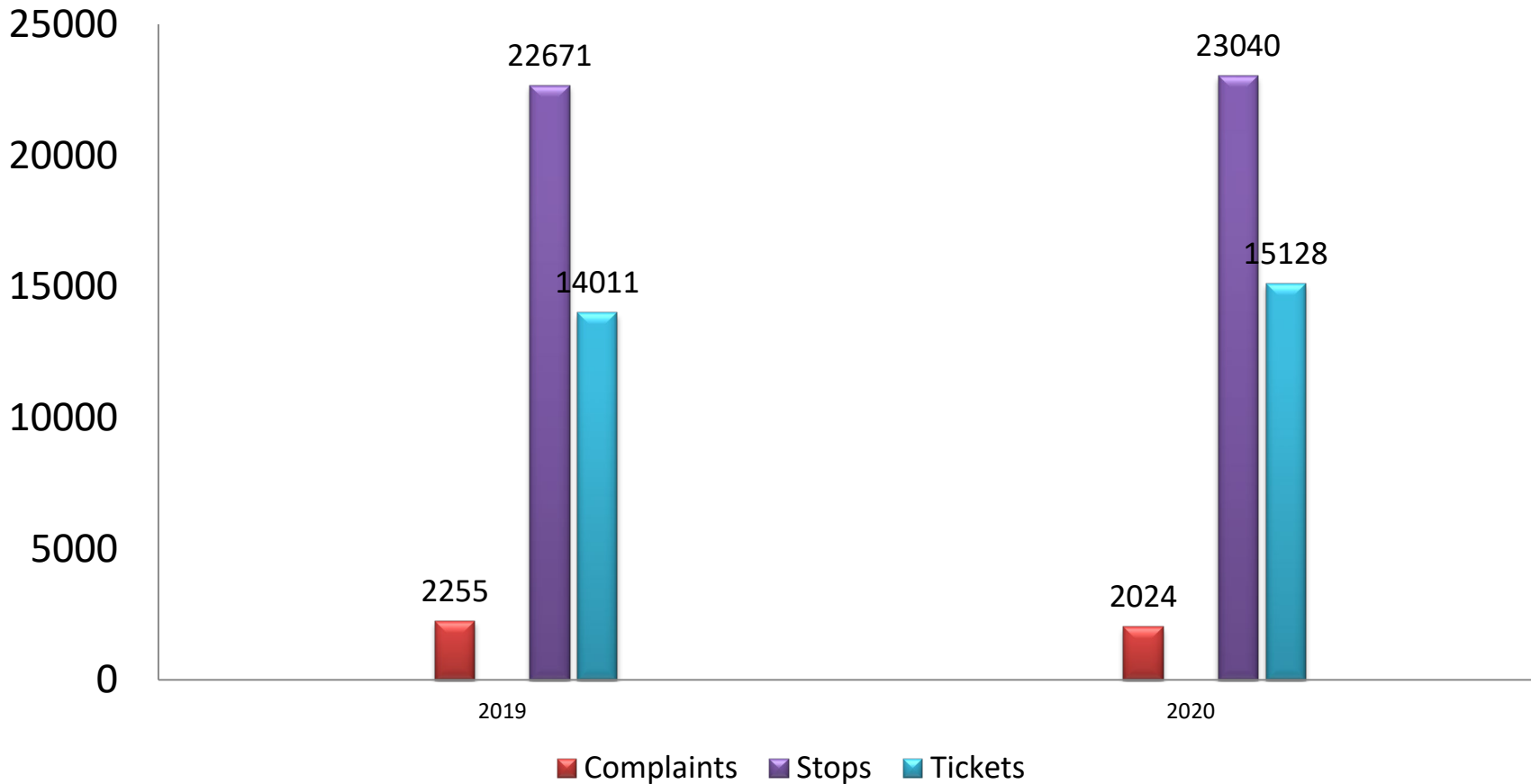

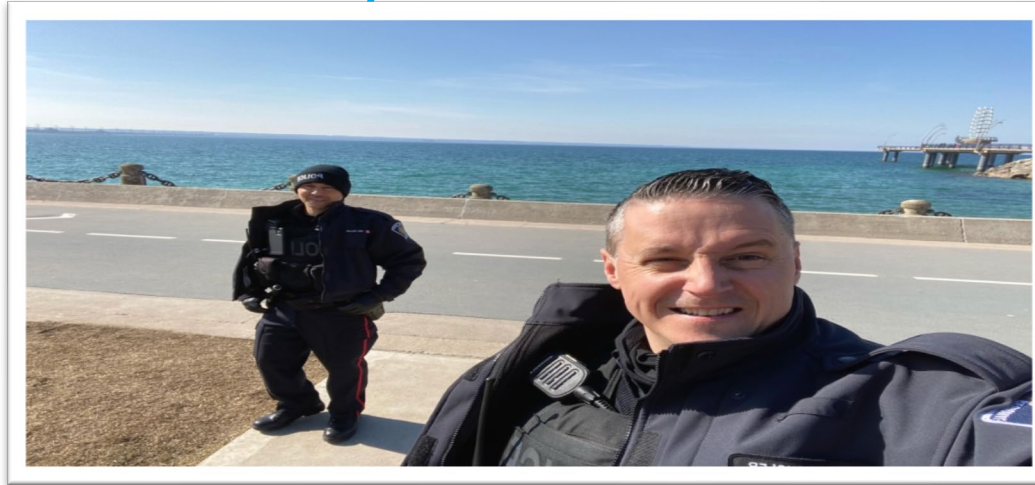

Community Engagement & Front-line Support

HSLO and ESLO

- Provide educational information and instruction to Burlington's elementary and high schools at both the Public and Catholic school boards
- Topics presented include internet safety, healthy relationships, anti-bullying, diversity and inclusion
- Investigate offences that violate the criminal code or other statutes that occur at the school (in person or virtually)

Community Officers and Youth Diversion

- Intervene with vulnerable sector residents and connect them with community support services
- These residents include isolated seniors, people struggling with mental health challenges, substance misuse, difficult parent and child relations
- Pro-active patrols in identified communities to interact with all residents and visitors to Burlington
- Youth Officer and Social Worker provide alternative judicial measures for young people who have committed a low threshold criminal offence

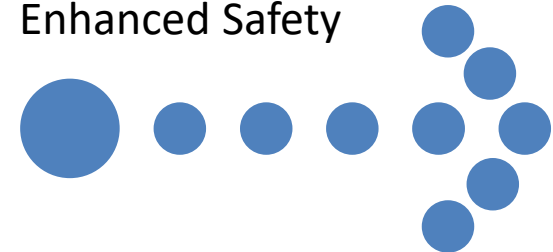

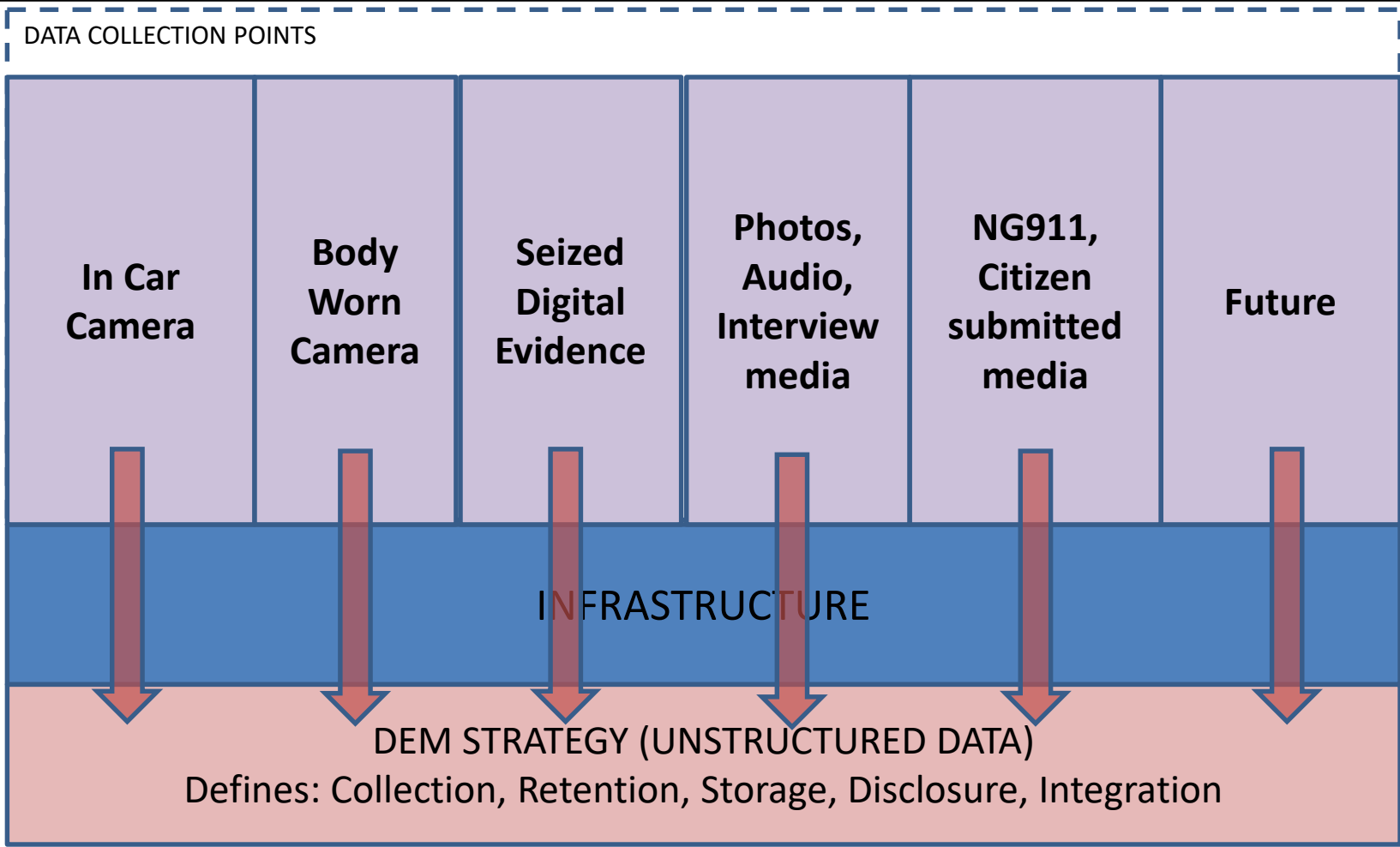
