Heritage Planner Update: June 9, 2021 (virtual)

- 1. Discussion of heritage property not listed on the Register
 - The City of Burlington has been circulated on an application to the Niagara Escarpment Commission (NEC) to demolish an existing dwelling on the property known as 6507 Jane Street (formerly 2087 Alice Street). The subject property is not heritage-designated nor listed on the City's Heritage Register, however it was listed on the City's Inventory.
 - Despite not being listed on the City's Register, the NEC has its own responsibility to
 consider heritage value when they consider applications under their own policies in the
 Niagara Escarpment Plan. Due to community interest expressed to the NEC, they
 required the property owner to complete a heritage evaluation of the property
 (attached). The City is circulated on the application, but the NEC is the ultimate approval
 authority.
 - The attached Heritage Impact Assessment finds that the subject property does not meet criteria prescribed by Reg. 9/06 for determining cultural heritage value or interest.
