Whereas schools are an essential service in all communities and should be protected as much as possible from the need to be closed because of COVID-19 spread; and

Whereas the Halton Regional Council passed a similar resolution on September 15th, 2021,

Therefore be it resolved that Burlington City Council requests that the Province of Ontario first examine and choose methods to reduce community contacts, should they be required, other than closing schools in order respond to rising number of COVID cases; and

That Burlington City Council endorses the written submission by the Council of Medical Officers of Health to the Province of Ontario regarding this issue; and

That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Premier of Ontario, Minister of Health, Minister of Education, and Burlington's MPP's for their information.
