


Melita Aquilina

I live at the neighbourhood housed a surprising amount of older seniors (surprising because most of the homes involve a number of stairs) who were so happy in their homes that they were reluctant to move, In the past couple of years, however, some these long-time residents, mostly original owners, have made other arrangements and some homes have changed hands. We are now a beautifully mixed street of both elder people, young families as well as single people and couples. My street is one with only semi-detached homes, although the blocks around the area include detached homes and townhouses as well as low rise buildings, both individually- situated and grouped together.
