City of Burlington By-law 60-2021

A by-law to amend By-law 31-2021 to provide for the rules of order of Council and its Committees
File:110-04-1 (CL-31-21)

Whereas section 238(2), of the *Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25* requires that every municipality and local board shall pass a procedure by-law for governing the calling, place and proceeding of meetings; and

Whereas the Corporation of the City of Burlington (the “City of Burlington”) has enacted Procedure By-law 31-2021; and

Whereas in 2017, Bill 68, Modernizing Ontario's Municipal Legislation Act, amended the *Municipal Act* to change the term of office for Council to begin on November 15 in an election year;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

1. Section 21 of By-law 31-2021 is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and inserting the following in its place:

21. Inaugural Meeting of Council

21.1 Following an election, the inaugural meeting of Council will be held in Burlington at 6:30 p.m. on the first Tuesday following the start of the new term of office, being November 15, at a location to be fixed by the Clerk.

2. Subject to the amendments made in this By-law, in all other respects, By-law 31-2021 is hereby confirmed unchanged.
4. This By-law comes into force on the date of its passing.
