City of Burlington By-law XX-2021

A by-law to appoint a Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer for the City of Burlington (CL-30-21)

Whereas Section 286(1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, (the "Municipal Act") states that a municipality shall appoint a treasurer who is responsible for handling of all the financial matters of the municipality on behalf of and in the manner directed by the Council of the municipality;

And whereas Section 286(2) of the Municipal Act designates authority to municipalities to appoint a deputy treasurer who shall have all the powers and duties of the treasurer under any other Act;

And whereas there are certain statutory powers and duties that only a treasurer or deputy treasurer may perform;

And whereas it is desirable to a appoint deputy treasurer to facilitate the conduct of the business of the Corporation of City of Burlington, particularly during the absence of the treasurer;

And whereas appointment of statutory officer positions is typically conducted through Bylaw;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Joan Ford is hereby appointed as the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer for the City of Burlington, retroactive to July 9, 2012.
- 2. That Ann Marie Coulson is hereby appointed Deputy Treasurer for the City of Burlington.
- 3. Where any By-law passed prior to this By-law conflicts with the provisions of this By-law, the terms of this By-law shall prevail.
- 4. That this By-law shall be known as the "Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer Appointment By-law".
