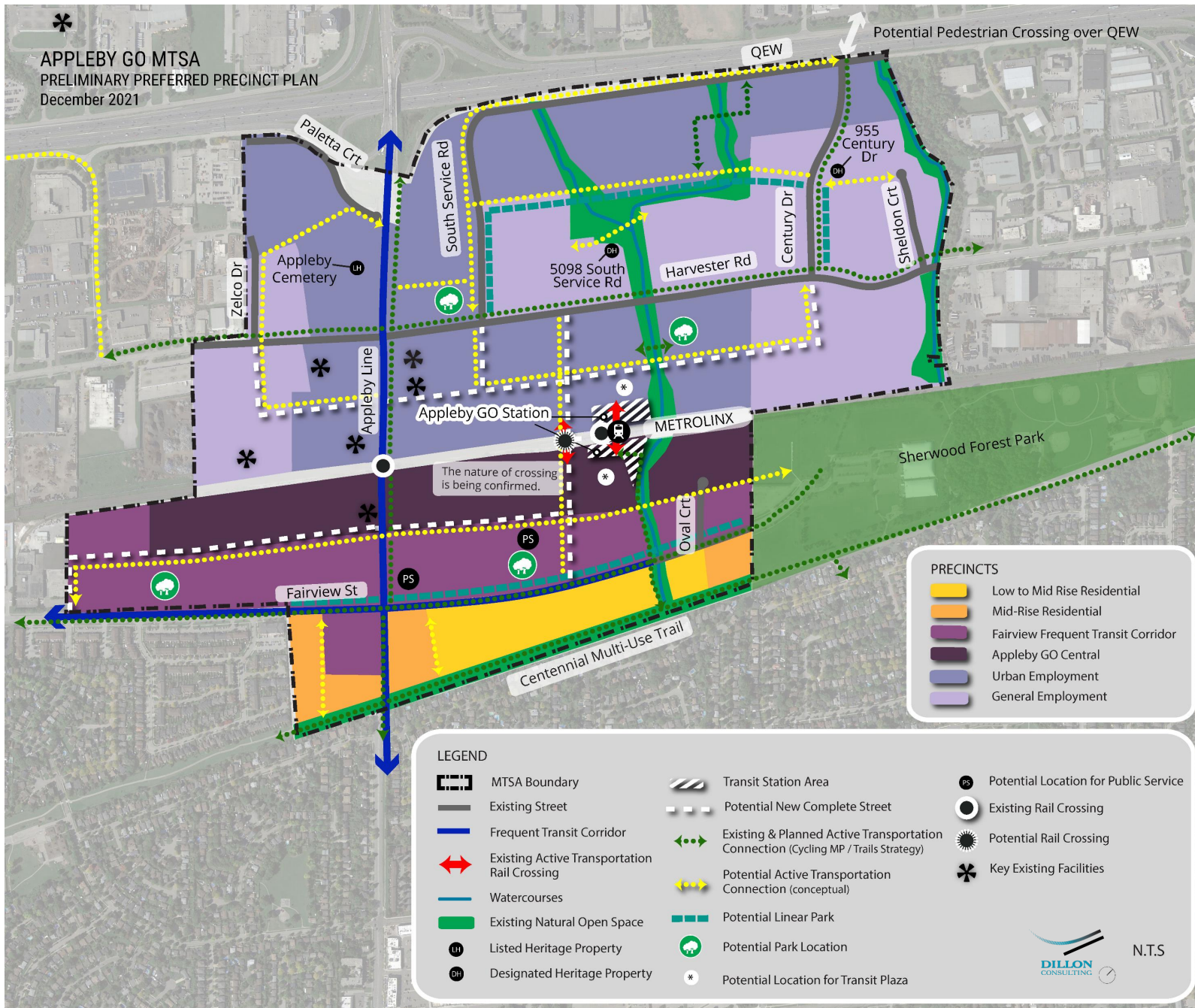


# Aldershot GO MTSA Recommended Preferred Precinct Plan





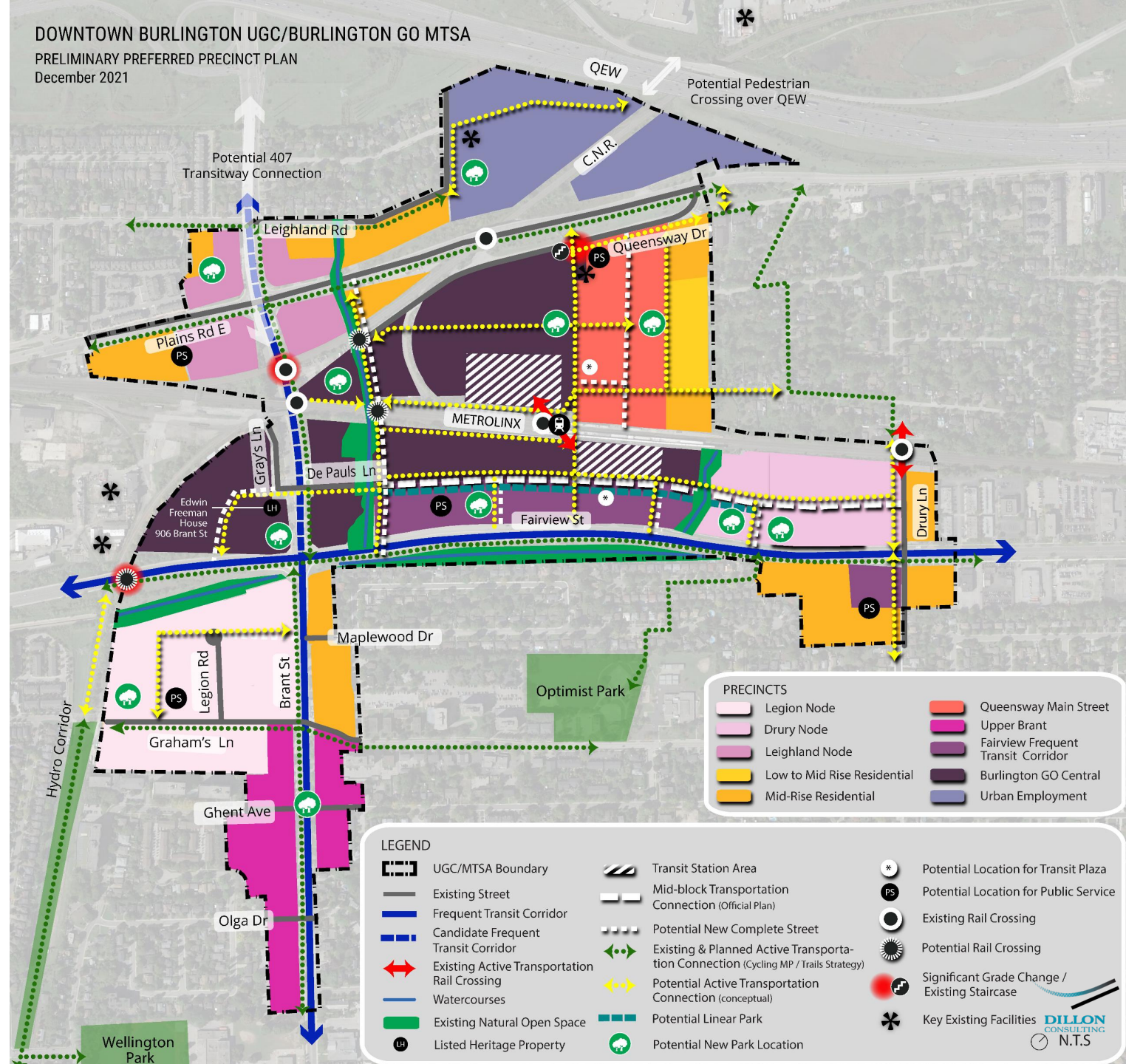
# Appleby GO MTSA Recommended Preferred Precinct Plan





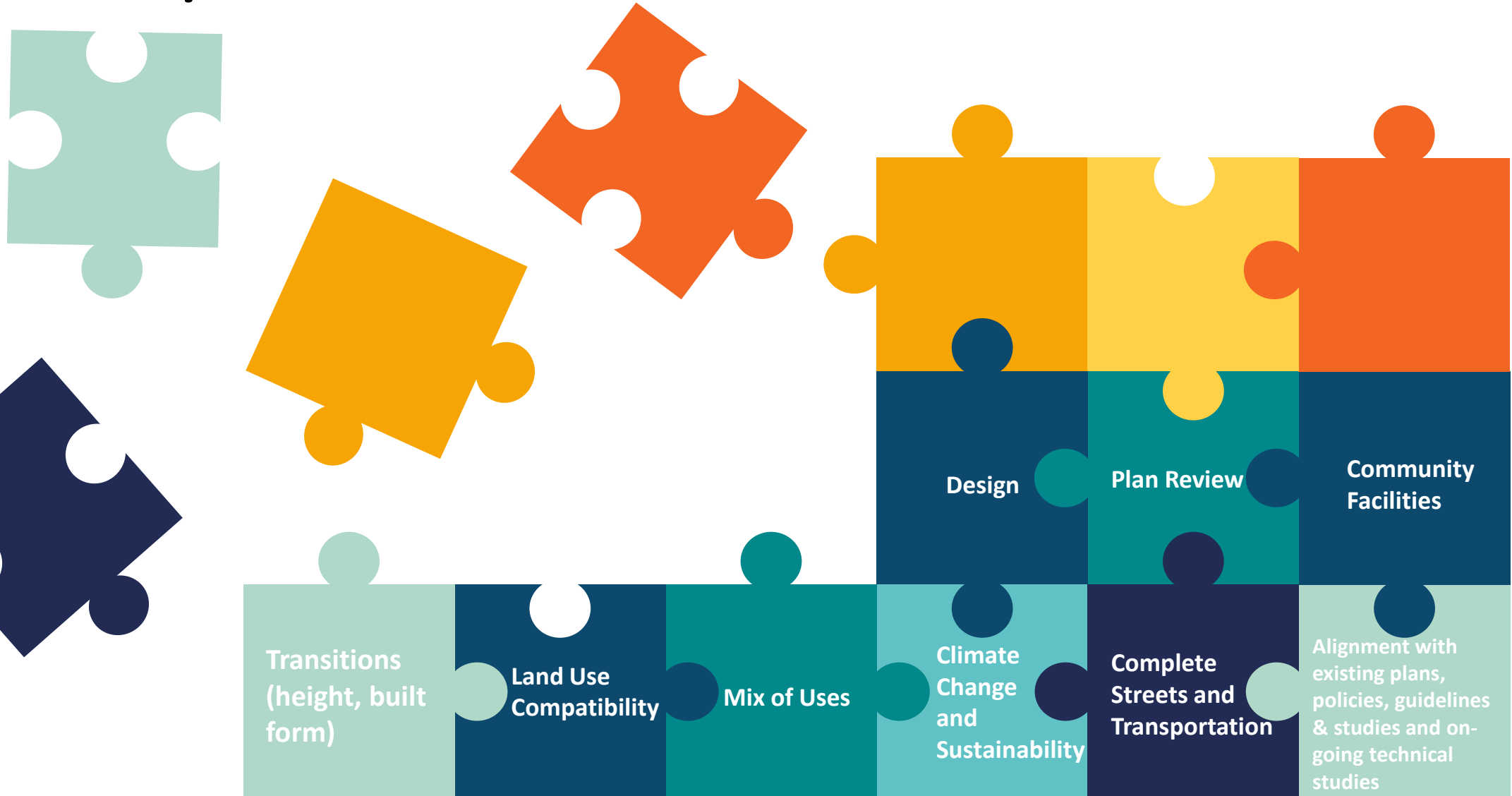

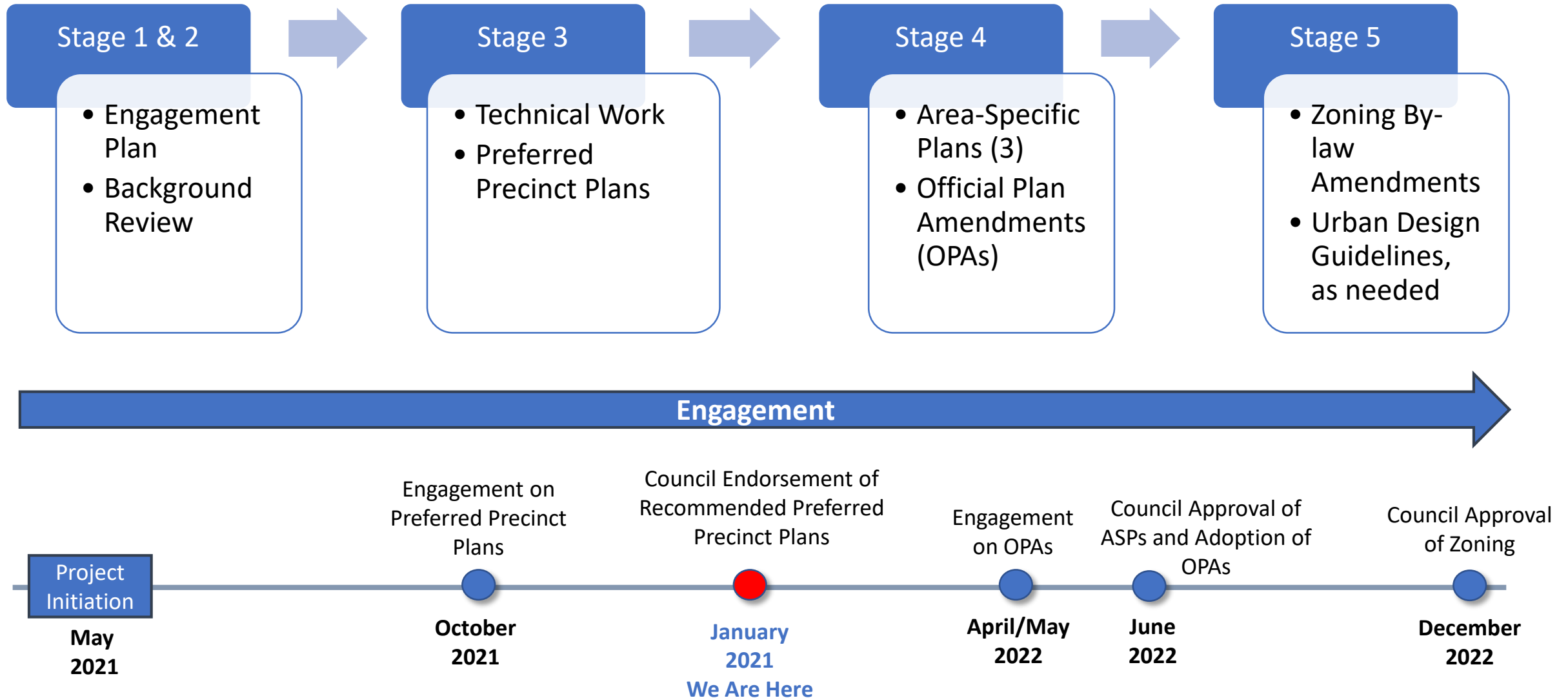
