City of Burlington By-law 05-2022

A by-law to authorize the execution of amendments and ancillary documents to the 2018 Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling Program Transfer Payment Agreement

Whereas it is deemed expedient to authorize the execution of amending agreements, ancillary documents or future agreements with Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario, as represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario, for funding under the dedicated Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling Program;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Burlington amendments to the Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling Program transfer payment agreement between Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario, as represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario, and The Corporation of the City of Burlington, extending the term and scope of the agreement, in a form satisfactory to the Executive Director of Legal Services and Corporation Counsel, or designate; and
- 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Burlington any amendment to the Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling Program agreement or other ancillary documents necessary to fulfill the OMCC requirements, in a form satisfactory to the Executive Director of Legal Services and Corporation Counsel, or designate; and
- 3. That the Corporation of the City of Burlington commits to implementing projects and spending funding in accordance with all provisions specified in the OMCC Transfer Payment Agreement, as amended.
