City of Burlington By-law 13-2022

City of Burlington By-law 13-2022 to amend By-law 34-2007, a by-law to regulate the size, use, location and maintenance of signs and advertising devices within the City of Burlington

Whereas, section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001 authorizes municipalities to pass bylaws respecting signs; and

Whereas the City of By-law has a stand alone by-law to regulate the placement of election signs; and

Whereas, it is deemed necessary to amend by-law 34-2007 to provide clarity and remove duplication of the term election sign provisions;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. By-law 34-2007 is amended by deleting section 3.15, the election sign definition:
 - ELECTION SIGN means a sign advertising or promoting the election of a political party or a candidate for public office in a federal, provincial or municipal election.
- 2. By-law 34-2007 is amended by deleting section 5.14:
 - "No person shall erect an election sign on a street or other City property."
- 3. Subject to the amendments made in this By-law, in all other respects, By-law 34-2022 is hereby confirmed unchanged.
- 4. This By-law comes into force on the date of its passing.
