Samantha, I am writing you to express my concerns about the New Waterfront Development on Lakeshore Rd and Elizabeth. I live in the Bridgewater Condos and my terrace looks out over Elizabeth Street so I see the traffic and congestion during rush hours and especially Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays right in front of the condo and Pearl Hotel sometimes blocking the garage entrance. In the summer, pedestrians are constantly walking up and down the middle of Elizabeth St. to get to the water and walking paths. Adding another Hotel and Condo entrance off of Elizabeth is just a bad idea. Elizabeth has too much traffic now with people, cars, limos and service trucks. Just this weekend the bottom circle of the street was filled with cars just sitting looking out at the water while having their lunch, coffee etc.

My other concern is during the construction of the new development. Where will the workers and equipment enter the site? Hopefully they will put in there own entrance near

Brant St. to eliminate extra traffic and safety for pedestrian walking to the waterfront from Elizabeth.

I've attached photos of limos from last year when the hotel just opened, while it was still under construction. Now that the Pearl Hotel is completed, there will be far more activity on Elizabeth Street then last year, we don't need more limos, trucks and cars to add to the already existing problem.
