City of Burlington By-law 19-2022

A by-law to authorize the execution of the transfer payment, and any other ancillary document(s) or amendment(s), between the City of Burlington and the Province of Ontario regarding the Streamline Development Approval Initiative Fund

Whereas it is deemed expedient to authorize the execution of the transfer payment agreement or any future amending agreements or ancillary documents with Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario, as represented by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, for funding under the dedicated Streamline Development Approval Initiative Fund

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Burlington the Transfer Payment Agreement for the Streamline Development Approval Initiative Fund ("Agreement") between Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario, as represented by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, and The Corporation of the City of Burlington, in a form satisfactory to the Executive Director of Legal Services and Corporation Counsel, or designate; and
- 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Burlington any amendment to the Agreement or other ancillary documents necessary to fulfill the Streamline Development Approval Initiative Fund requirements, in a form satisfactory to the Executive Director of Legal Services and Corporation Counsel, or designate; and
- That the Corporation of the City of Burlington commits spending the Streamline Development Approval Initiative Fund funding in accordance with all provisions specified Agreement.
