

Heritage Burlington Committee March 9, 2022 Recommendation: *Heritage Burlington recommends that the property at 795 Brant Street be added to the Municipal Register.*





795 BRANT STREET- History & Background

- Constructed in 1854 by builder Jabez Bent
- 75 acre property was farmed for 55 years
- Rear additions constructed during the 1900s
- Removed from the Register in 2015 to facilitate demolition
- Pre-Application Community meeting on October 21, 2021 for a development consisting of a 32-storey mixed-use building with 307 units


