- 1. Climate Action Plan
 - a. Electric Mobility Strategy community surveys have wrapped up for electric vehicles, ebikes and e-scooters (stand up scooters with an electric motor). Working on draft proposed actions and planning to post on <u>www.getinvolvedburlington.ca</u> The <u>Plug'n</u> <u>Drive MEET</u> EV test drive event continues until May 20th.
 - b. **Renewable Energy** there is a community survey on <u>www.getinvolvedburlington.ca</u> (under the Climate Action Plan) for residents to provide input on their experience of installing renewable energy measures or if their thoughts on opportunities and barriers if they have not. The survey runs until the end of May.
