The closing date is planned for September 30 2022. No transaction information can be released until the deal is completed. This is standard municipal practice and in accordance with the City and board agreement of purchase and sale.

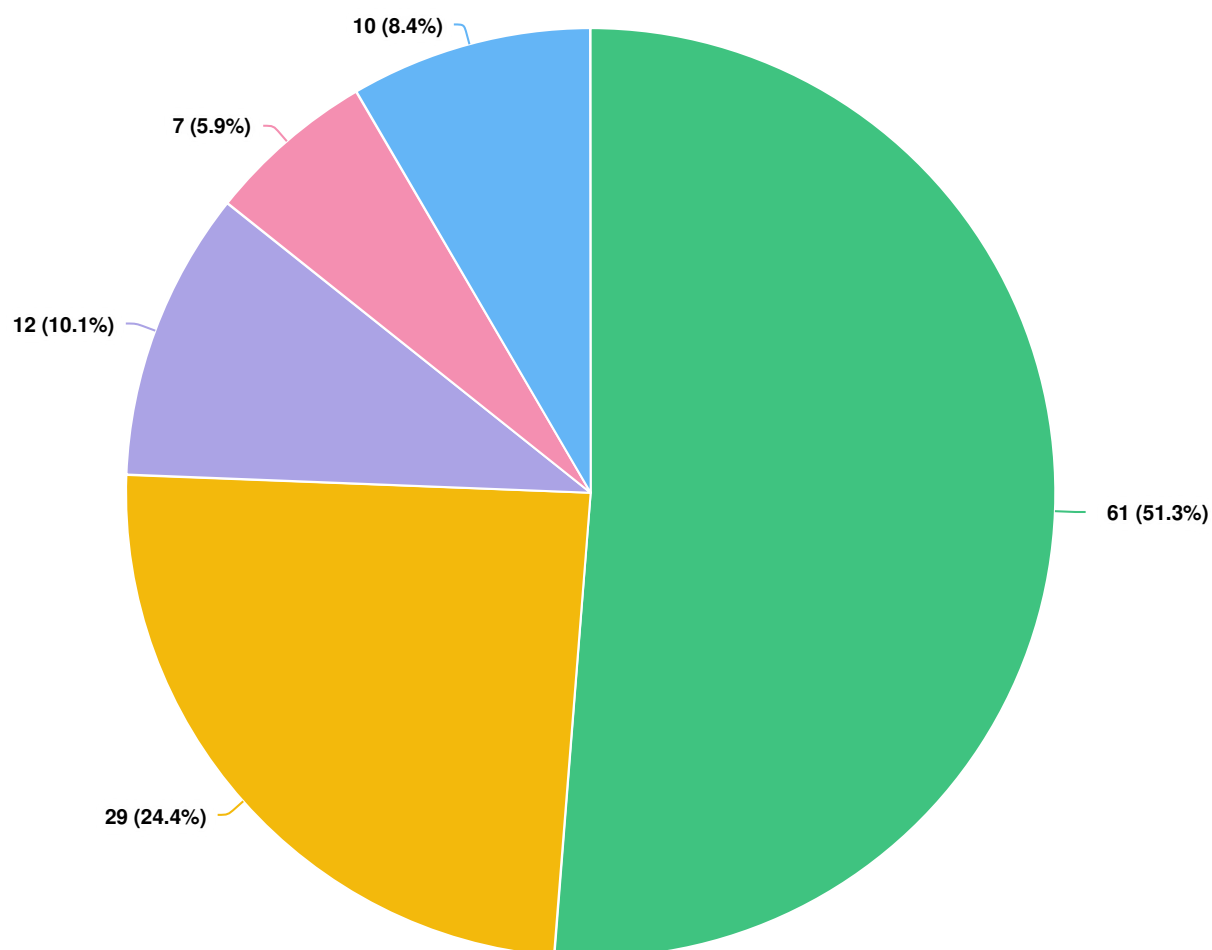

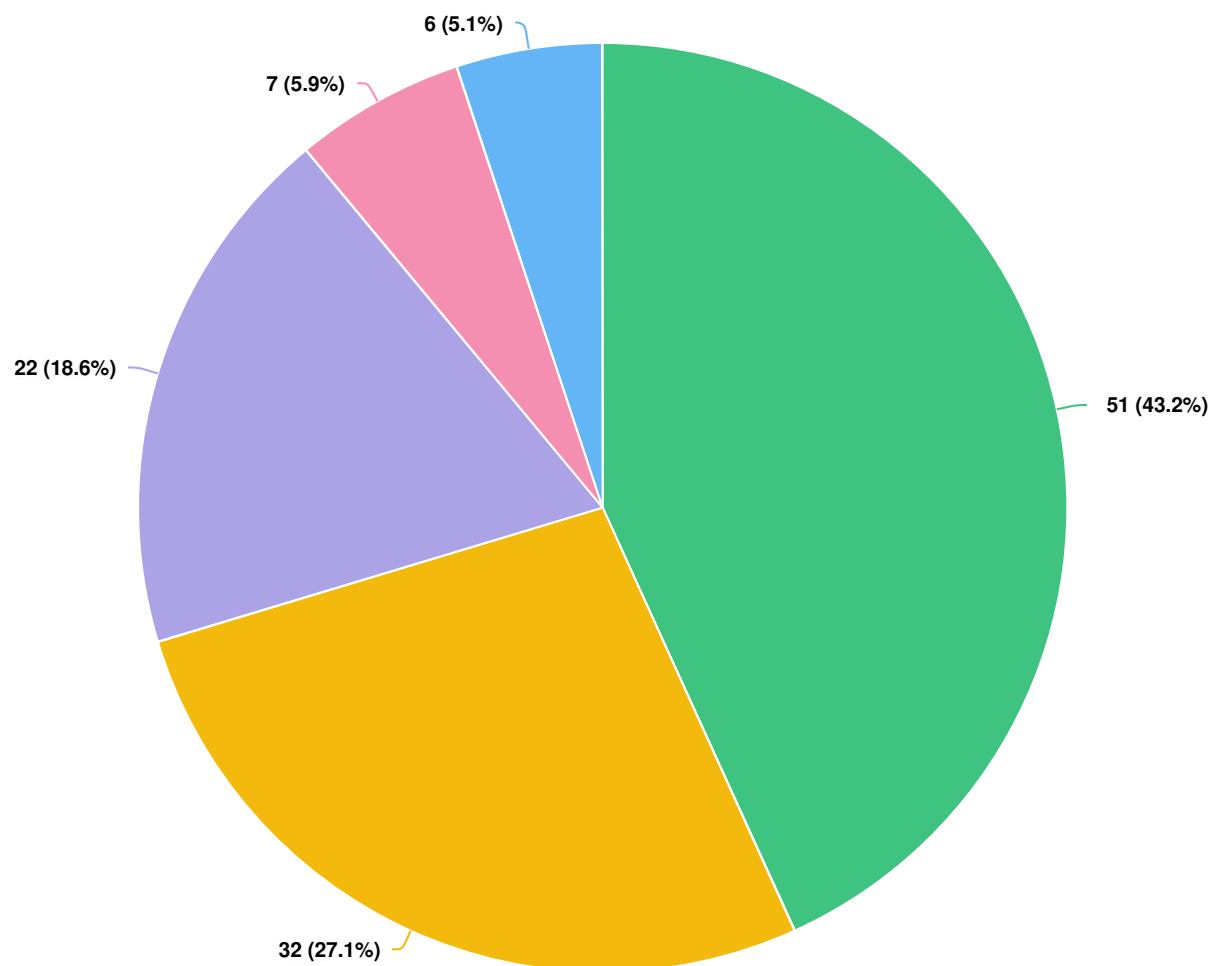
