The City of Burlington's new 25 year Strategic Plan gave a clear direction for Burlington Economic Development (Burlington EcDev) to develop a strategy for growing local talent, supporting existing businesses, and nurturing the start up and growth of new companies. The team hit the ground running, and within a year presented a comprehensive innovation and entrepreneurship strategy that included a recommendation to establish a physical space in Burlington where start ups and innovation could thrive.

We focused on creating connectivity, vibrancy, and telling the entrepreneurial story through three key areas:

- Space & Energy
- Mentorship & Support
- Capital & Growth

TechPlace was the first of its kind as a government led innovation centre, and has been recognized on multiple levels as a best in class example of how economic development agencies can support innovation and entrepreneurship. Over the last five years, TechPlace has established itself as a destination for new and growing technology companies, allowing technology, talent, and ideation to come together under one roof.

We are incredibly proud of what we've been able to accomplish over the last five years, despite the obvious effects of the COVID 19 pandemic. - LaunchPad offices reach capacity.

2021

- Haltech receives additional funding from FedDev to expand their Accelerator for Women Entrepreneurs, Beyond Boundaries.

2022

- Haltech receives \$600,000 for i.d.e.a. Fund cohort 1.
- TechPlace.ca redesign to improve overall user experience.
- Haltech, TechPlace, and Innovation Factory partner with LatAm Startups and receive \$3,000,000 to launch Acceleration+, a program focused on delivering specialized resources for international expansions.
