Re: Update regarding finalization of report for "Phase 2 Downtown and

Burlington GO Major Transit Station Area Flood Hazard and Scoped SWM

Assessment"

In the Committee of the Whole meeting held on February 1, 2023, staff were directed to provide an update regarding the status of the Phase 2 report and the anticipated schedule for finalization and approval from Conservation Halton (CH). The following provides the requested update:

- The Phase 2 study was initiated in July 2021.
- Most recent comments were received from CH on January 24, 2023
- City staff met with CH staff on February 8, 2023 to review our comment responses and our consultant (WSP) is currently revising the report.
- Our Final Report submission is anticipated by March 3, 2023.
- CH also requested details and confirmation of the property ownership and maintenance responsibilities for
 the Hager-Rambo stormwater management facilities (much of which was designed and constructed by CH)
 that play a major drainage role in the Phase 2 study area. A summary of the Hager-Rambo Flood Control
 System SWM facilities has been provided to CH. CH staff will review this summary for approval, to fulfil their
 requirements of the Phase 2 study.
- Following resubmission, staff will continue to coordinate with CH staff to expedite final approval of the report.
- Upon approval of the report, CH will then undertake to update their regulatory mapping. This is expected to include a public meeting.
