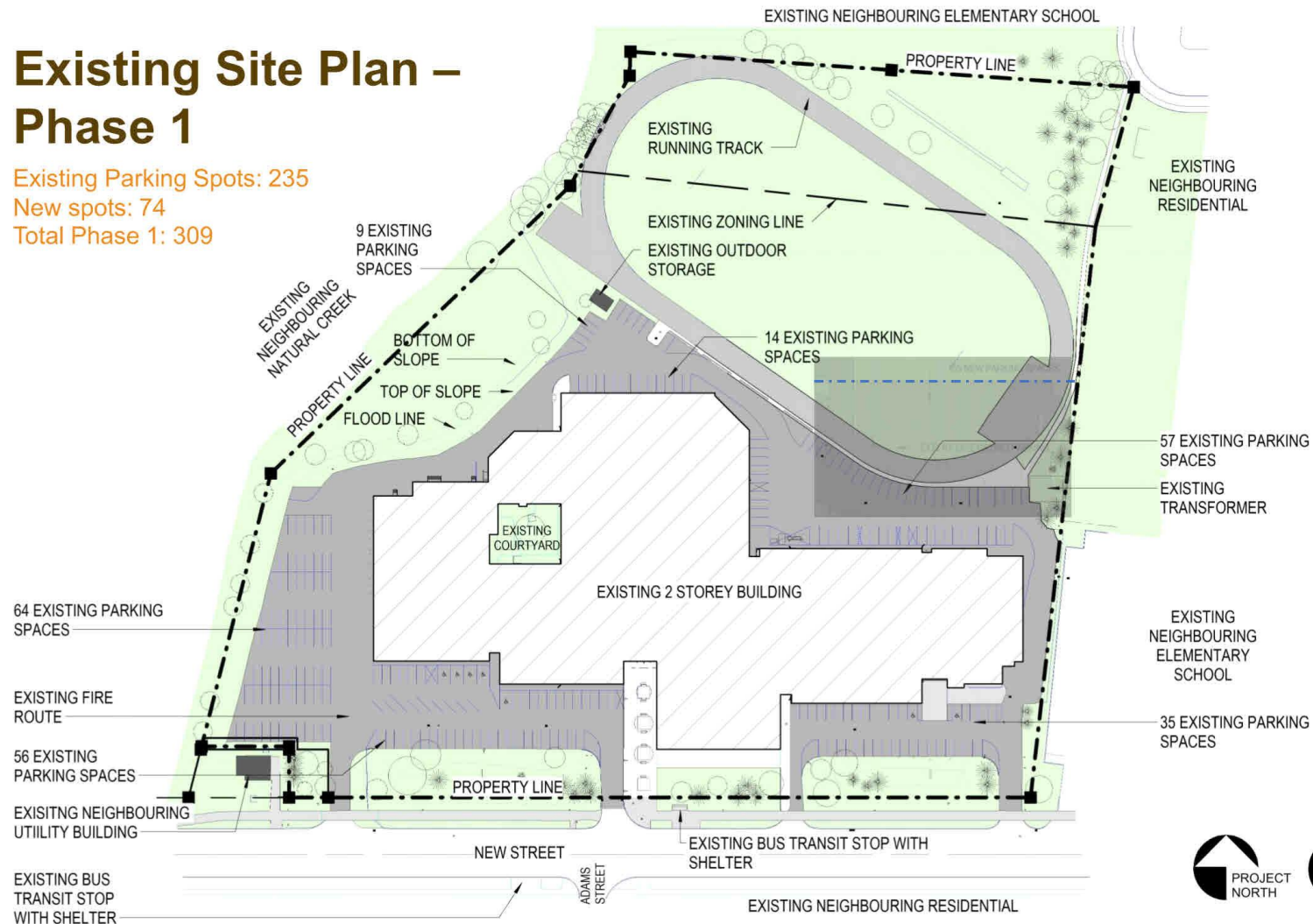
# Public Meeting May 31 2022.

## Existing Site Plan – Phase 1

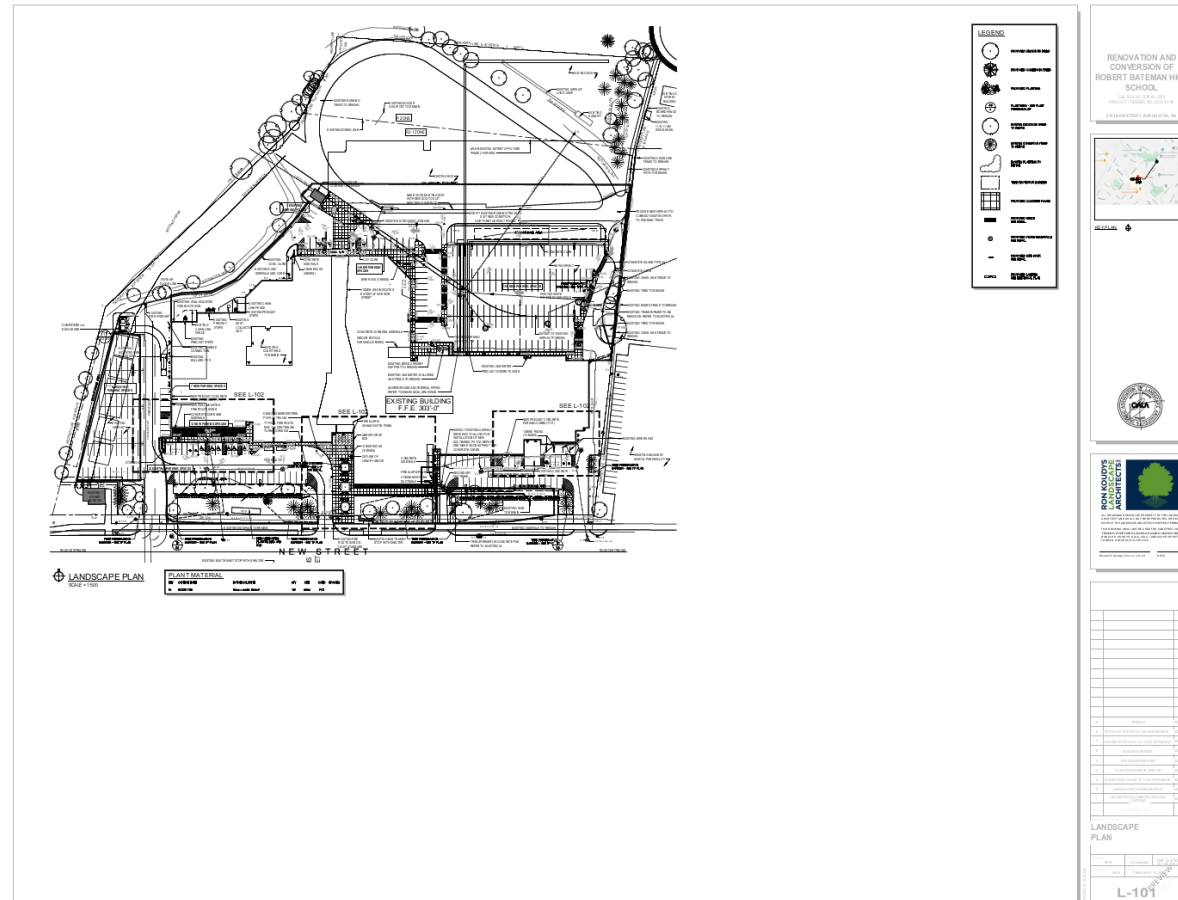
Existing Parking Spots: 235

Total Phase 1: 309



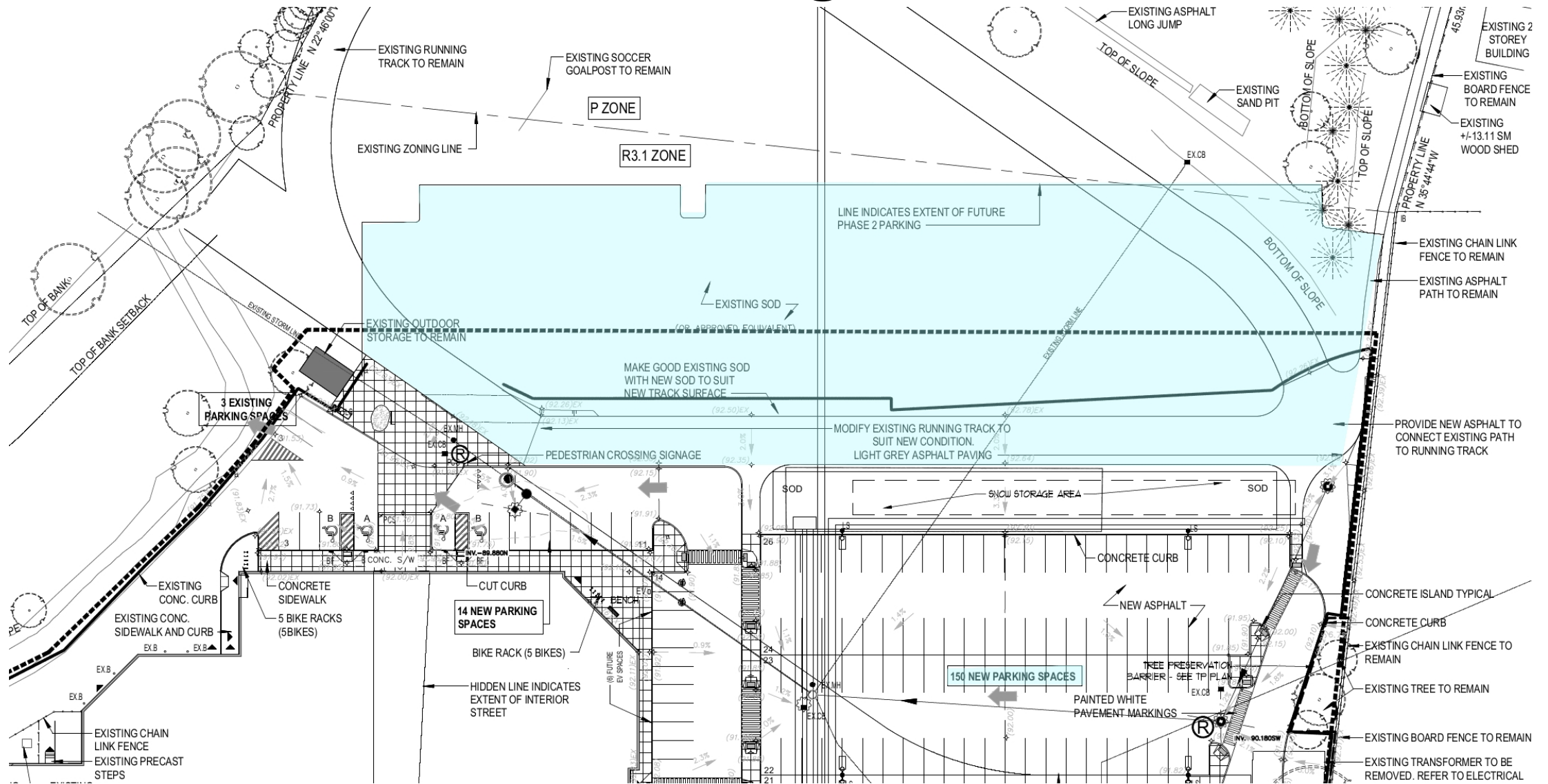
# Current Report
