

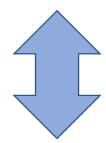
Complete Communities as defined by A Place to Grow; Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshow
