Am writing with respect to the upcoming decision regarding the future of the Tyandaga Golf Course. It is my understanding that the proposed change will amend the golf course from 18 to 9 holes, and the remaining land will be used for driving ranges and other outdoor uses (hiking trails, etc.).

My concern is the change in scope of the space. As a resident, and someone increasingly concerned about the reduction of public recreation space, it is my hope that we can receive reassurances that this space will be preserved as city-owned recreation land and continue to operate as a golf course. I worry that the reduction in revenue from changing the course size will justify later decisions to sell the course and/or parcel land for private sale. This would be a detriment to the city, its residents, and the local neighbourhood.

We urge you to take action to protect the golf course, as it undergoes changes, such that it remains a space for the community.
