### Summer Youth Programming—Recreation Services

#### **Executive Summary:**

Within Stage 1 of the Province, only Online / Virtual Programming was in place. Entering Stage 2, Summer Youth Programming will be gradually reintroduced, including a modified / smaller version of Day Camps, Student Theatre and the Burlington Team Tour Band. As we look to re-introduce recreation program, services and facilities, Youth Programming will be gradually staged to reopen based on provincial guidelines, lifted restrictions, coordination through professional associations / governing body (e.g. OCA, PRO, ORFA), demand, and cost implications.

- A continuation of virtual / online programming including practices and rehearsals will remain with potential growth.
- A gradual re-introduction of smaller sized (20-max) Day Camp Programs situated at community Centres: Haber, Brant Hills, and Tansley Woods. 1-week programs with a morning shift and an afternoon shift. Program focus to remain outside with some inside reprieve. Each group of 20 would be split into a group of 10 with 2 staff.
- A micro version of Student Theatre with ½ day options with no in person shows / performances. Programming to be offered at the Student Theatre facility.
- Burlington Teen Tour Section practices offered in groups of 10. No performances, tours or full band performances. Some practices may occur outside under the bandshell or in the park.
- As we enter into Stage 2, program offerings may be added or expanded.

### **Financial Implications:**
