Service Re-design Interim Program Changes and Modifications

Sport Fields – Recreation Services

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Executive Summary

Stage 1 - Sport Fields (natural only) are open for general community access only with no organized sport occurring (e.g. no permitting of the fields). Moving into stage 2, we will gradually stage the reopening of various Sport Fields for restricted permitted use by organized sport organizations.

Organizations that are looking to provide individual activities (e.g. soccer) and / or smaller groups (currently a maximum of 5) will be gradually staged to reopen based on provincial guidelines, lifted restrictions, coordination through provincial governing bodies / professional associations (e.g. OSA, PRO, ORFA), confirmed demand, and cost implications.
