City of Burlington By-law 60-2024

A by-law to appoint a Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer for the City of  
Burlington, and to repeal By-law 08-2022

Whereas Section 286(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, (the “Municipal Act”) states that a municipality shall appoint a treasurer who is responsible for handling of all the financial matters of the municipality on behalf of and in the manner directed by the Council of the municipality; and

Whereas Section 286(2) of the *Municipal Act* designates authority to municipalities to appoint a deputy treasurer who shall have all the powers and duties of the treasurer under the *Municipal Act* and any other Act; and

Whereas there are certain statutory powers and duties that only a treasurer or deputy treasurer may perform; and

Whereas it is desirable to appoint deputy treasurer to facilitate the conduct of the business of the Corporation of City of Burlington, particularly during the absence of the treasurer; and

Whereas appointment of statutory officer positions is typically conducted through By-law;

Now therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Craig Millar is hereby appointed as the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer for the City of Burlington.
2. That Ann Marie Coulson is hereby appointed Deputy Treasurer for the City of Burlington.
3. That this By-law shall be known as the “Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer Appointment By-law”.
4. That by-law 08-2022, being a by-law to appoint the Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer for the Corporation of the City of Burlington, be repealed.
