Burlington is evolving from a suburban community to a city. The city is changing, especially in our downtown. As more residents and businesses move to Burlington, this impacts how we choose to get around. Parking plays a crucial role in this. Where you can park, for how long and how much it costs determines if you walk, cycle, take transit, drive or ride share.

The City has retained Stantec to undertake the Burlington Downtown Parking Plan, which will help us determine future parking needs that support growth and land use in the downtown area. Having a strategic downtown parking plan will result in better parking options and financial sustainability.

Public engagement and stakeholder consultation is vital. Opportunities for involvement and input will be provided throughout the project and include public information centers, and engagement workshops with targeted stakeholders.
