BACKGROUND:

Attached to this Report is a letter dated November 28, 1996 from the Region of Halton concerning the matter of governance in the Region of Halton.

The Region has received a verbal commitment from the Minister of Municipal affairs and Housing, the Honourable A. Leach, that legislative amendments would be presented to reflect the restructuring decisions which have been endorsed within the Region of Halton. On November 27, 1996, the Region of Halton reconfirmed its position on Regional restructuring and has requested that the Council of the City of Burlington do likewise and forward a resolution to the Minister.

The City of Burlington Council supported the downsizing of Regional Council on June 27, 1996, in conjunction with a reduction of our own Council size through the following resolution:
