


Site Specific OPA and Rezoning

- OPA + Rezoning the 6m +/- tall rock fill area to permit the King plant relocation from Howard and Waterdown Road
- Updated King plant will use latest technology in terms of dust and emissions control subject to strict MOECP regulations
- Reduced plant and storage footprint with continuous feed and just-in-time aggregate delivery
- Respects the natural environment


Technical studies support these applications

Benefits of King Plant Relocation

- Allows Waterdown Road Major Transit Area to redevelop
- Removes heavy truck traffic from Plains Road
- Modernizes the former Halton landfill access with a paved laneway
- King will maintain the landfill access road for Halton
- King will remove and replace invasive species
- Retains key employer
