## **Motion for Council to Consider:**

Direct the Commissioner of Public Works to report back to Committee of the Whole on May 12, 2025 with a list of identified infrastructure projects that could be quickly advanced if federal and/or provincial stimulus programs are announced.

## Reason:

In anticipation of the negative effect that American tariffs will have on the Canadian economy, upper levels of government are expected to provide stimulus infrastructure funding. During the provincial electoral campaign, Premier Ford announced in January 2025 that if re-elected, his government will spend \$22 billion to build infrastructure as part of a stimulus package in the face of a possible trade war with the United States.

The City of Burlington needs to be well-positioned to apply for stimlus funding opportunities from the province or the federal government, which may have applications with tight turnaround times and short deadlines.

## **Outcome Sought:**

Provincial or federal stimulus funding for City of Burlington infrastructure projects.
