City of Burlington By-law 20-2025

A by-law to amend the Procurement Policy By-law 04-2022 (F-15-25)

Whereas section 270(1)3 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c 25 provides that a municipality shall adopt and maintain a policy with respect to its procurement of goods and services; and

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the City of Burlington passed By-law 04-2022 as a procurement policy; and

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the City of Burlington deems it necessary to amend By-law 04-2022, as amended to expand invitational bidding thresholds;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Burlington hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Subsection 25.2 b.is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following new subsection:
 - b. invitational Bids may be requested for values up to but not including \$133,800 from a minimum of three Vendors;
- 2. Subsection 25.3 b. be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following new subsection:
 - b. invitational Bids may be requested for values up to but not including \$133,800 from a minimum of three Vendors.
- 3. Subsection 25.4 b. be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following new subsection:
 - b. invitational Bids may be requested for values up to but not including \$133,800 from a minimum of three Vendors;
- 4. Subject to the amendments made in this By-law, in all other respects, By-law 04-2022 is hereby confirmed unchanged.
