As a long time resident of the above mentioned community, I object to the boundary change that would make it part of Aldershot and ward 1.

By no stretch of the imagination is the Leighland community part of Aldershot. It is a unique neighbourhood with only two roads in and out. One off Brant Street and the other off Plains Road.

Considerable high density development is proposed on west Brant Street backing onto this community with another development planned immediately on the east side of Brant Street.

On the corner of Plains Road and Helena as you drive into the neighbourhood, is another development proposal. Vehicular access into and out of the community at this point, is awaiting proper road construction and alignment related to the new development which began before Covid and has yet to be completed.

Most of the flooding in the whole of ward 2 occurred in the homes of this neighbourhood.

Other future high density development is proposed throughout mid town and downtown Brant Street and along Plains Road, which will impact this community in one way or another. To make sure its interests are fully protected, it should remain part of the ward where all this development is taking place, ward 2. It just makes sense!

The current ward Councillor, Lisa Kearns already knows and understands the needs of this community. She is hands on and in touch with the residents. She already has the knowledge and knows the history of the neighbourhood to help achieve the best possible outcomes for this community's future.
